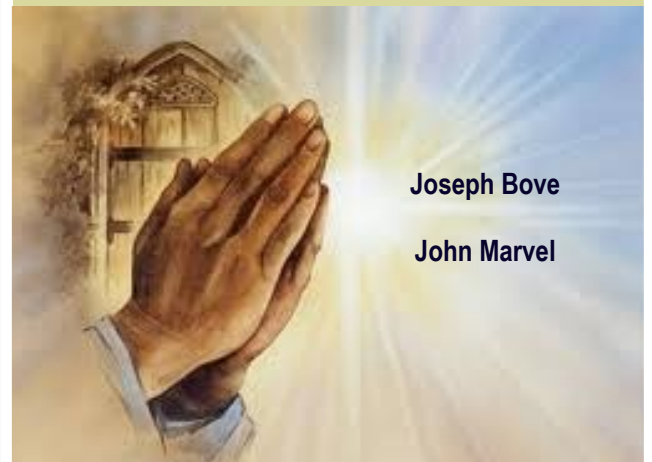

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

The priests over the next few weeks will be speaking on the Holy Mass. It's various parts and expand on the meaning of what is taking place. This is in conjunction with a Renewal of the Our Love for the Holy Eucharist. Saint Francis of Assisi once said, "Man should tremble, the world should quake, all Heaven should be deeply moved when the Son of God appears on the altar in the hands of the priest." Reverence and awe should be present if we really know what is going on during the Mass. I have heard people speak of a priest being a good celebrant as though he is there to entertain. Regrettably, when the modern Mass or Novus Ordo came into being, there was a lot of emphasis on the priest. Does he smile, is he cheerful or does he say a "quick one?" The emphasis, as in all things, is adoration and love for the Father, through the Son in the unity of the Holy Spirit. All of our prayer is directed in this way. The priest is in the person of Christ and offers an unbloody Sacrifice to the Heavenly Father. Our uniting ourselves to this action brings about incredible grace for us even if we are unable to receive Holy Communion. Why would we not receive Holy Communion? Firstly, one must be a Catholic. Protestant Christians do not believe in transubstantiation and the Eucharist is a symbol of unity (we are divided sadly). Secondly, one may have committed mortal sin (serious matter, serious reflection, and full consent of the will) and therefore, receiving the Lord in this state would be a sacrilege. It is a serious sin to miss Holy Mass on any Sunday without the gravest of reasons. I am confident that when we go before the Lord, we would regret any time we chose anything over being with Him at Mass! Certainly, the Mass is not a show or for entertainment. The ancient Romans once said, "Just give them bread and circus!" Wikipedia describes "Bread and circus" as "a metonymic phrase referring to superficial appeasement. It is attributed to Juvenal, a Roman poet active in the late first and early second century AD, and is used commonly in cultural, particularly political, contexts. In a political context, the phrase means to generate public approval not by excellence in public service or public policy, but by diversion, distraction, or by satisfying the most immediate or base requirements of a populace, by offering a palliative: for example food (bread) or entertainment (circuses). Juvenal originally used it to decry the 'selfishness' of common people and their neglect of wider concerns." While Juvenal was speaking about the political realm, this phrase has been used by proper liturgists who railed against "clown Masses" or other types of hootenannies at Mass. Dignified, humble, and loving service is what is called for during the Mass. It is not about "community," but rather, the community, being the Body of Christ, adoring Almighty God. The Angelus Press wrote in the front of the 1962 Missal: "The Host and the Chalice upon the altar plead before God on our behalf just as our Lord sacrificed on the Cross pleaded for us on Good Friday because it is identically the same sacrifice which is renewed on our alters in an unbloody manner." Come, let us worship!

Saint's Corner: St. Abigail, was a medieval Irish saint born around the 6th century in County Clare, Ireland. According to tradition, Abigail's family was always feuding which caused her to run away from home. After some time, an angel appeared to Abigail and told her this was not her place of resurrection. She was to head inland to find the place she would spend the rest of her life. The angel told Abigail this place would be marked with the presence of nine white deer. Abigail set off in search for the deer and she finally found the herd of deer. Abigail would spend the rest of her earthly life dedicated to pastoral service and Christian charitable work. Her brother, St. Abban is believed to have joined her to help set the foundation for a convent, placing Abigail as its abbess, or mother superior of the community of women religious. Abigail also went on to spend much of her time caring for the sick. According to early Celtic folklore and religious symbolism, the soul departs from the body in the form of a bee or butterfly. So, it is not surprising that, given her deep Christian faith and belief in the Resurrection, Abigail also became a beekeeper. It is said that she developed a powerful relationship with the bees and would use their honey to treat illnesses and heal wounds. She became known for her miracles in rousting bees from their hives and using them to chase off evil. Some pious legend even claim that the bees transformed into soldiers, with their hives becoming helmets. St. Abigail is the patron saint of honeybees and beekeepers. She is often featured surrounded by bees or carrying a honeycomb. Her feast day is celebrated on February 11.

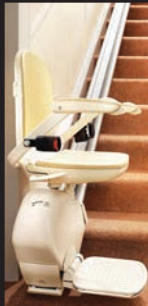
