A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

As we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving as a nation, I want to assure the faithful of Our Lady of Hope that I consider serving you a great blessing. As Scripture offers, “I never stop giving thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, would give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him” (Ephesians 1:16-23). The traditional antidote to selfishness which seems so prevalent in our society is thanksgiving. When we examine our conscience at night, we should spend more time thanking the Lord than going over sins and asking forgiveness. Certainly we need to be aware of our sins and repent, but Saint Ignatius of Loyola reminds us that the blessing, goodness and generosity of God are so much larger than even our foolish sins. President Abraham Lincoln, in a proclamation on October 3, 1863, said “...with humble penitence for our national perverseness and disobedience, commend to His tender care all those who have become widows, orphans, mourners or sufferers in the lamentable civil strife in which we are unavoidably engaged, and fervently implore the interposition of the Almighty Hand to heal the wounds of the nation and to restore it as soon as may be consistent with the Divine purposes to the full enjoyment of peace, harmony, tranquility and Union.” These words apply to our current time. I would think it a time to give thanks for the blessings upon our nation and to put aside this Thursday the anger and negativity that seems to be growing. There is so much strife in the world that despite the challenges in our country, we remain blessed by the favor of Almighty God. On behalf of the priests, deacons and staff of Our Lady of Hope, we wish you a very blessed and enjoyable Thanksgiving holiday.

A fun fact underlying the practice of gratitude is that the word "gratitude" is actually derived from the Latin word "gratia"-- which means grace.

Before going to bed at night, think of 2 or 3 things/ people/ events for which you are grateful. Give thanks to God for these things. It can actually improve your health.

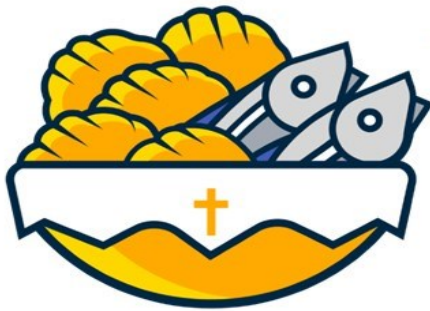

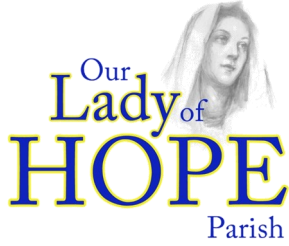

Saint's Corner:

St. Sebastian is a popular male saint, especially today among athletes. In medieval times, he was regarded as a saint with a special ability to intercede to protect from plague, and devotion to him greatly increased when plague was active. Due to his courage, strength and perseverance, Saint Sebastian is highly regarded as both a Christian saint and a martyr. Martyrs are people who have died for their beliefs, and are highly regarded in Christianity. Saint Sebastian is the patron saint of athletes, archers and soldiers. When opportunity presented, he accosted the mighty emperor denouncing him for his cruelty to Christians. For this, he was sentenced to death and beaten to death with clubs. Saint Sebastian's life demonstrates his courage and love for Jesus Christ. He valued fidelity to Christ higher than any worldly honor. Sebastian is the patron saint of persecuted Christians. You can ask him to pray for you if you are being persecuted for your Faith, or you can ask him to pray for a persecuted Christian whom you know. The St. Sebastian prayer is "O Lord, grant us the spirit of fortitude, so that guided by the example of the martyr St. Sebastian, we may learn to bear witness to the Christian Faith and patiently support the sufferings of life. Through Christ Our Lord." Amen.

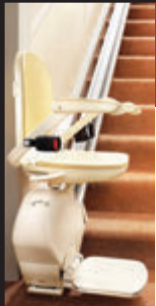
