A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

We now enter the holy season of Advent. This is a penitential season, thus our altar will not be overly decorated (though not as stark as during Lent), the priests and deacons will wear the color violet, our Advent wreath will descend from the ceiling with each candle being lighted as the four weeks unfold and the readings will be rich in prophecy with a call to prepare for the coming of the Lord. The very word “Advent” means “coming” which is a return of the Lord Jesus. A very popular song during the season of Advent is *O Come, O Come Emmanuel*.

*O come, O come, Emmanuel,
And ransom captive Israel,
That mourns in lonely exile here
Until the Son of God appears.
Rejoice! Rejoice!
Emmanuel shall come to thee, O Israel.*

We see in the first line a calling out for the Lord to come to us. The very name Emmanuel means “God with us.” We should reach out to the Lord Jesus and ask Him to be present in our midst and to expand in our lives. The word “ransom” is to pay for the release of a prisoner. We are prisoners of sin and death. This world so often offers us a cage rather than freedom. The Lord Jesus wants us be free to bear fruit in the Holy Spirit as seen in the fifth chapter of Saint Paul’s letter to the Galatians: “The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.” The Lord makes it possible for our soul to bear this fruit. The song speaks of mourning. How sad people seem today! Even at Mass, people leave early and without a nod of greeting. An encounter with the Lord should bring us joy! Perhaps many are carrying heavy burdens and are in mourning for what could be. The Infant Jesus wants to make us smile. He wants us to rejoice and to wait for Him. This will not happen without an active relationship with the Lord. We must pray, confess our sins, attend Holy Mass, read the Word and pray the Holy Rosary. The Lord desires to come into our lives in an even deeper way! “Lift up your heads, you gates; rise up, you ancient doors that the King of glory may come in.” (Psalm 24:9).

**Blessing & Prayers
for Advent Wreath**

Prepare for the approaching celebration of the birth of Christ.

An Advent wreath is a wreath of laurel, spruce or similar foliage with four candles that are lighted successively in the weeks of Advent to symbolize the light that the birth of Christ brought into the world. Traditionally three of the candles are purple, the color of kings and of penance. A rose-colored candle is used to mark the Third Sunday of Advent as a time to rejoice over the closeness of Christmas and the coming of Christ.

Each day your family should gather around the Advent wreath, generally before the evening meal. The proper number of candles are then lighted and a prayer is said.

BLESSING OF THE ADVENT WREATH

It starts at the evening meal on the Saturday before the first Sunday in Advent with the blessing of the wreath. (The head of the household is the one designated to say the prayers, following which various members of the family light the candles. The following prayer can be used.

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

All: Who made heaven and earth.

Leader: O God, by whose Word all things are sanctified, pour forth Your blessing upon this wreath and grant that we who use it may prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ and may receive from You abundant graces. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The wreath would then be sprinkled with water. Then follows the prayer which is said before the evening meal each night of the first week in Advent.

FIRST WEEK The following prayer should be repeated each day during the first week. After the prayer, the family's youngest child lights the first purple candle. (Family members can also take turns lighting and blowing out the candles on each night.)

Leader: O Lord, stir up Thy might, we beg Thee, and come, That by Thy protection we may deserve to be rescued from the threatening dangers of our sins and saved by Thy deliverance. Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

Before going to bed at night, think of 2 or 3 things/ people/ events for which you are grateful. Give thanks to God for these things. It can actually improve your health.

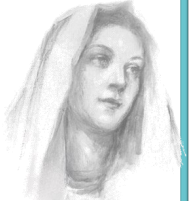

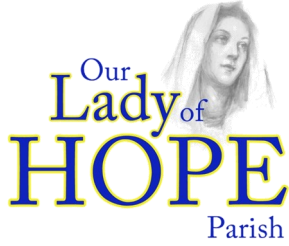

Confirmation 2023

The Candidates should be hard at work on their Confirmation packets. This is the time to look at the first assignment. This assignment is about choosing a Confirmation name. This is an extremely important assignment as this name will be recorded and with you for all time. Before choosing the name, do some research and be sure this is the name you actually want. Don't make a quick and sudden choice. Check into other names you may like. You may find a connection to another name that may suit you more. You may actually find another name what may be closer to you and your life than you realized. Be sure to remember, once this name is chosen and presented with your paperwork, you may not be able to change your mind.

Saint's Corner: St. Philomena is the patron saint of children and purity. Her father ruled Greece and in hopes of making peace, he took her to visit Rome. The Emperor fell in love with her and wanted to marry her. She had taken a vow of purity at a young age. When she refused the evil advances and marriage proposal of Emperor Diocletian, he then order he to be executed. He tried drowning her with an anchor and then he had her shot with arrows. Both times she was saved by the grace of angels. He then ordered her beheaded. When her tomb was found miracles abounded. Since then, many have come to know and love Philomena, often through miracles, for her heroic faith. Her feast day is August 11th.

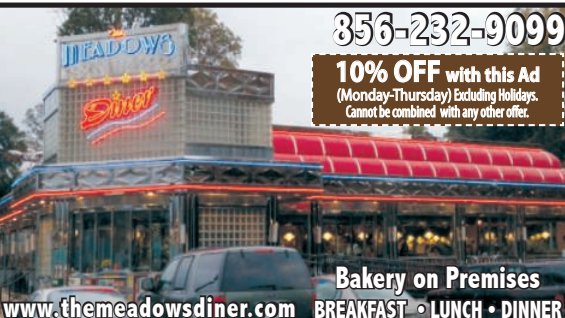

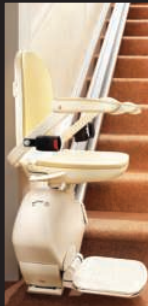
