A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Soon enough, we will be celebrating our parish feast day, Our Lady of Hope also known as Our Lady of Expectation. This year, we will celebrate Our Lady's Day in a special way. I am thrilled with the response of those who have made a donation for a Christmas ball to place their intention on the ball or inside of it. We have a lot of decorations for our two parish family trees. On Saturday, December 17th, immediately following the 4:30 PM Mass, we will gather out in front of the church for a blessing, tree lighting and singing of songs. Following the tree lighting, those who have already signed up can go over to the hall for dinner. At 7:30 PM, the hall is open to everyone for cookies and the singing of Christmas carols. We apologize that we had to limit the number to signups for dinner as the hall is only so big. If for some reason, you signed up, but cannot come, please call the office to let us know. We can then fill your place with someone who is on the wait list. I read an article about Christmas trees which noted: "We decorate our Christmas trees with a lot of ornaments and other things. As the significance of the Christmas trees, Christmas decorations have been passed down from generation to generation. But the interesting point to note is that every Christmas tree decoration symbolizes something different and unique.

- The lights on your Christmas tree represent the importance of knowledge and the warmth of family love.
- The red ornaments on your Christmas tree are believed to symbolize Jesus Christ's blood or sacrifice.
- The ribbons signify the family ties binding all the family members together during the holiday season and all through the year.
- The bells at the side of the tree branches symbolize the joy and happiness of the merry day.
- The star at the top represents the shining hope for humanity. It also symbolizes the star of Bethlehem, which guided three wise men to baby Jesus.
- The candy canes represent the shepherd's crook. The red stripes symbolize Jesus' sacrifice and blood, and the white lines represent his purity.
- Wreaths are the epitome of eternal love and rebirth.

Blessing & Prayers for Advent Wreath



THIRD WEEK *The joyful Sunday in Advent (known as "Gaudete") is represented by rose (or pink) instead of the penitential purple color. Each night during the third week the mother of the family lights the pink, as well as the two previously burned purple candles, after the following prayer has been said.*

Leader: O Lord, we beg Thee, incline Thy ear to our prayers and enlighten the darkness of our minds by the grace of Thy visitation. Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The three candles are allowed to burn during the evening meals of the third week.

The Third Sunday of Advent marks John Paul II's beloved tradition of **'Bambinelli Sunday.'** St. John Paul II began a tradition where he invited the children of Rome to assemble in St. Peter's Square on the Third Sunday of Advent during his Angelus address. He asked them to bring their little statue of the baby Jesus that would be placed in their Nativity set at home. John Paul II blessed the figurines of those present and told them to assemble before the manger scene with their family in a spirit of prayer. It is a beautiful Advent tradition, one that sanctifies the home with the baby Jesus and makes his arrival in the manger scene an even more joyous event.

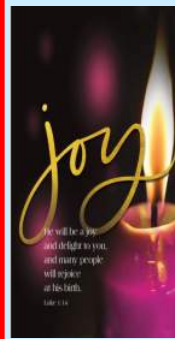

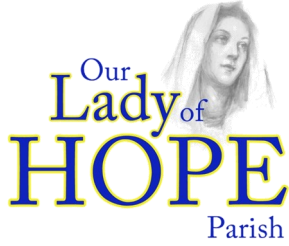

Saint's Corner:

St. Faustina is revered as the Apostle of Divine Mercy. She first felt the call to religious life at the age of 7 when she attended Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. She was repeatedly rejected for her appearance and looking too poor. She finally joined an order where she had to work to pay for her own religious habit. She kept a detailed journal where she wrote of her visions of Jesus and his messages. She stated in one message Jesus said, "I require you to make acts of mercy, which are to come from your love for me." You are always and everywhere to show mercy unto your neighbors; you may not withdraw, excuse or absolve yourself from this.

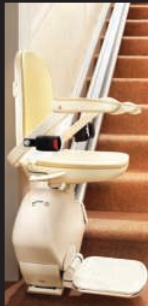
