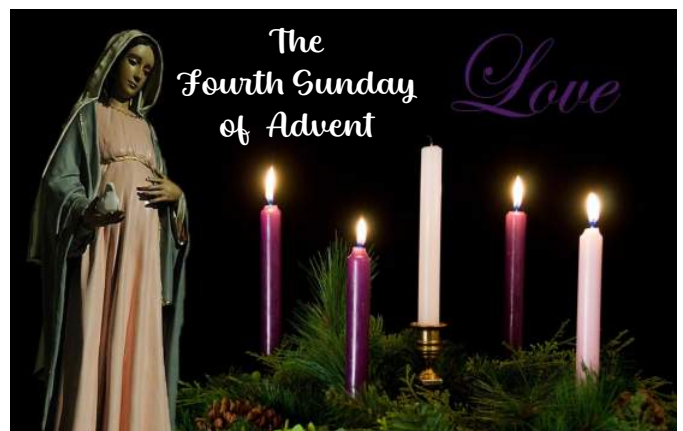

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

One of the great figures of the Advent Season is the Most Holy Blessed Virgin Mary. This past Monday, our parish celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This was carried out by the community of Saint Jude and was a mixture of both of our churches of Saint Jude and Saint Agnes. We began with the Holy Rosary and Novena to Our Lady of Guadalupe in Saint Jude Church. Our Lady had a beautiful shrine in Saint Jude's with lights, live roses and even a fountain. We then had a caravan of vehicles (protected and guided by the Gloucester Township Police Force) with the Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe with a man imitating Saint Juan Diego at the foot of the image. It was a frigid night, but we waved from opened windows as we wound our way through the neighborhood from Saint Jude to Saint Agnes. Las mañanitas or songs to the Blessed Mother were blasted from our caravan giving glory to the Mother of God. Father Rene and I were in the lead truck and Fathers March and Pinzon rode in the caravan as well. Upon our arrival at Saint Agnes we organized inside to watch a prayerful rendition of the apparition of Our Lady to Saint Juan Diego. We prayed a beautiful bi-lingual Mass with Father Rene gathering all the children present to lead them in honoring Our Lady's image with a mañanita and we ended with Father Rene calling out to various countries represented from South, Central and North America. This is most appropriate as Our Lady of Guadalupe is the Empress of the Americas. This weekend will also have seen a celebration of Our Lady of Hope or Our Lady of Expectation as our patroness is known. Our tree lighting adorned with Christmas balls filled with intentions followed by a Carol Party in the Parish Hall is our celebration of Our Lady of Hope to thank her for the love and graces she has obtained from her Son for our parish. The heart of Our Lady was and is forever filled with hope. Her feast day is officially December 18 which is the week before the birth of Jesus. During this period of waiting, she is called Our Lady of Expectation or Our Lady of Hope, since on each of the seven days before Christmas there is an antiphon in the liturgy that the Church attributes to her. All of these antiphons begin with the exclamation – "O!"

Heavenly Mother, dwelling on the blood-drenched Mount of St. Thomas! Mother expecting; and Mother bearing Christ in your holy womb! Shower thy blessings on us who venerate thee. Protect us from the treacherous Satan. Shelter us in the tabernacle of thy womb.

O Holy womb that bore our Lord Jesus Christ! Mold us as expected by your beloved Son. Let our families inculcate good virtues. Let thy peace fill our families. Let faithfulness be strengthened among couples. Let the voice of vocation be heard and answered. Let wisdom, understanding and knowledge be implanted in our children. Bless us with employment and industrial development. Bless us with good rain, agricultural growth and decent shelter. Bless us with the gift of Children. Bless pregnant mothers with safe delivery. Bless our journeys with safety and bless us with a burden-less life. Bless all those who have lost their spouse. Bless the orphans and the destitute, physically challenged and the socially afflicted; the poor and helpless. Let the priests and the religious lead a holy life. Let there be peace in the world. Let love for mankind, solidarity among religions and justice be established. Make us depend on Jesus Christ in our day to day life as you expect and may we say 'Yes' to God's Holy Will. Lord! Like the holy seeping blood which gushed out from the cross carved by St. Thomas, bless and make this Holy Mount the Faith Home of the World. Amen.

**Blessing & Prayers
for Advent Wreath**



FOURTH WEEK *The prayer that follows is to be repeated each day of the fourth week. After the prayer, the father lights all four candles.*

Leader: O Lord, stir up Thy power, we pray Thee, and come; and with great might help us, that with the help of Thy Grace, Thy merciful forgiveness may hasten what our sins impede. Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The four candles are allowed to burn during the evening meals of the fourth week.

After the fourth week, the penitential season of Advent is over and the time to rejoice is at hand. The Advent wreath is transformed into a Christmas wreath. Ribbon and candles are replaced with red ribbon and long red or white tapers (to be lighted at breakfast on Christmas morning) and, if desired, other festive decorations can be added.

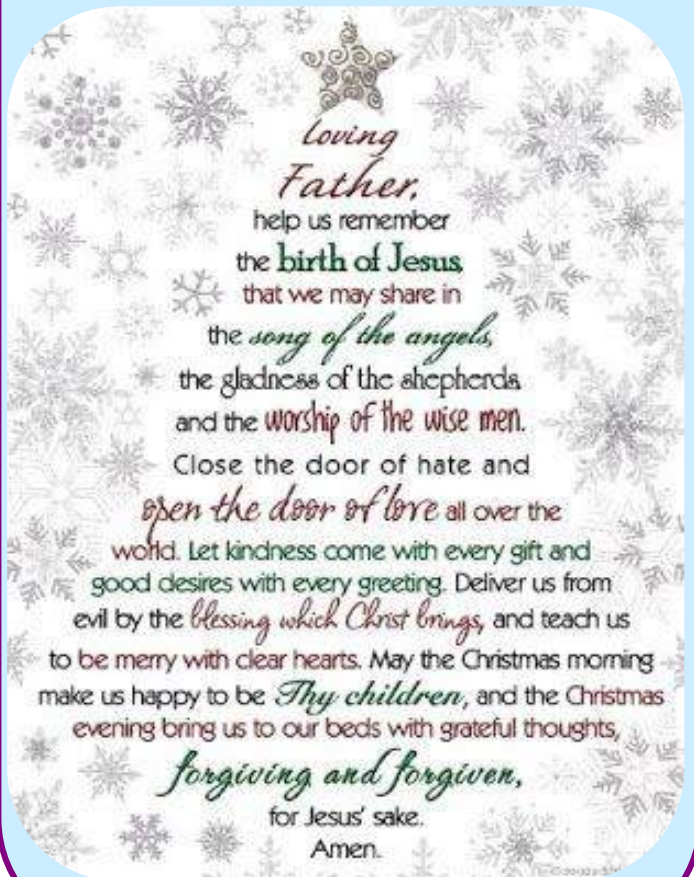

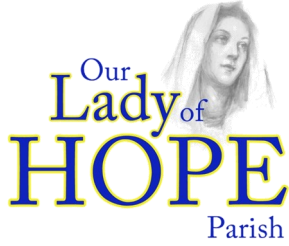

Saint's Corner:

St. Gerard Majella, religious, is the patron of expectant mothers. He was born at Muro, Italy, in 1726 and joined the Redemptorists at the age of 23, becoming a professed lay brother in 1752. He served as sacristan, gardener, porter, infirmarian, and tailor. However, because of his great piety, extraordinary wisdom, and his gift of reading consciences, he was permitted to counsel communities of religious women. This humble servant of God also had the faculties of levitation and bilocation associated with certain mystics. His charity, obedience, and selfless service as well as his ceaseless mortification for Christ, made him the perfect model of lay brothers. He was afflicted with tuberculosis and died in 1755 at the age of twenty-nine. This great saint is invoked as a patron of expectant mothers because of a miracle effected through his prayers for a woman in labor.
