A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy New Year! In this New Year there may be a temptation to lose hope and to believe that the darkness in the world cannot be kept at bay. In reality, the year 2023 gives us more time to grow in holiness and to become the person that the Lord wants us to be. Fear is a trick of the devil. He uses fear to paralyze us so that we will not take chances to love, to get out of ourselves. Many of us may have made resolutions. Have we made spiritual resolutions? If we look back at the last year, we should see what we have become. The Lord is offering us new opportunities every day to discover what it means to be a Catholic Christian. The word “disciple” means “a student or learner.” There is only one person who can teach us the meaning of life and who gives us the strength to triumph over self: He is the Lord Jesus Christ! In this coming New Year, may God give us the grace to follow His call to become better; better men and women; better disciples of Jesus. 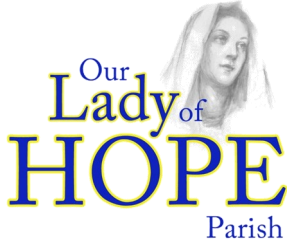

First Penance Retreats:

There are 2 First Penance Retreats scheduled for January. The first one will be held on 01-11-2023 for the last names A-L from 6:00pm—8:00pm in the church. These children will be making First Communion on April 22, 2023. The second one will be held on January 25, 2023 for last names M-Z from 6:00pm—8:00pm in the church. These children will be making First Communion on April 29, 2023. You will receive 2 videos to go over with your children before the retreats. We will discuss them during the retreat. If you have spoken to us regarding a date change for your First Holy Communion, follow the schedule you were given. If you have any questions, please contact the Faith Formation office.

First Holy Communion:

First Holy Communion are rapidly approaching. We have some children who still need to be registered for their sacrament. Also, there will be videos sent out the first week of January 2023. These videos will contain the subject matter they will be discussing at their First Penance Retreat. Please make sure the children view these videos as they will discussing these in the retreat.

Saint's Corner:

St. Lucy, Italian Santa Lucia, (died 304, Syracuse, Sicily; feast day December 13), virgin and martyr who was one of the earliest Christian saints to achieve popularity, having a widespread following before the 5th century. She is the patron saint of the city of Syracuse (Sicily) and of virgins. Because of various traditions associating her name with light, she came to be thought of as the patron of sight and was depicted by medieval artists carrying a dish containing her eyes. According to apocryphal texts, Lucy came from a wealthy Sicilian family. Spurning marriage and worldly goods, however, she vowed to remain a virgin in the tradition of St. Agatha. An angry suitor reported her to the local Roman authorities, who sentenced her to be removed to a brothel and forced into prostitution. This order was thwarted, according to legend, by divine intervention; Lucy became immovable and could not be carried away. She was next condemned to death by fire, but she proved impervious to the flames. Finally, her neck was pierced by a sword, and she died. Lucy was probably a victim of the wave of persecution of Christians that occurred late in the reign of the Roman emperor Diocletian. References to her are found in early Roman Sacramentarians and, at Syracuse, in an inscription dating from 400 CE. As evidence of her early fame, two churches are known to have been dedicated to her in Britain before the 8th century, at a time when the land was largely pagan. St. Lucy is venerated on her feast day, December 13, by a variety of ceremonies. In Sweden, St. Lucia's Day marks the beginning of the Christmas celebration. On that day the eldest daughter of the family traditionally dresses in a white robe and wears as a crown an evergreen wreath studded with candles. The festival is meant to bring hope and light during the darkest time of the year.
