A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

We have an incredibly special time of the year coming up this week, our annual Forty Hours Celebration. Holy Mother Church is requesting that we renew and expand our love for the Lord's Real Presence in our midst. Our parish is extremely centered on prayer in the presence of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Our Forty Hours of love for the Lord will begin after the 9:00 AM Mass on January 17th with perpetual prayer before the Holy Sacrament day and night until the closing, which will take place on Thursday, January 19th. The only interruption of prayer before the Sacrament will be for the celebration of the Masses. On Tuesday, January 17th, Wednesday, January 18th and Thursday, January 19th we will celebrate Holy Mass each night at 7:00 PM in our Saint Agnes Church. Father Edward Kennedy will be the homilist each of these nights. On Wednesday, we will have confessions after the 7:00 PM Mass as adoration continues. Our closing of Forty Hours on Thursday will involve a procession with the Blessed Sacrament in the Church. I encourage all to attend, in particular, it is appropriate for all who serve in any way at Mass. It is especially right for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Altar Servers to walk in procession with the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. Please plan on spending as much time as possible each of the days during Forty Hours. The Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration write, "The most powerful thing we can do on this earth with our time is to spend it in Eucharistic adoration. Nothing can do more to change the world, to bring about peace, to convert hearts, to make reparation for the many evils committed. Spending time in prayer may seem, on the outside, to be a passive thing; however, it is anything but! Our world is in desperate need of hope, of renewal, of a 'turning back' to the things of God. By visiting Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, we take up the best weapon for the battles of our age and contribute to the healing of our culture. Cultivating a Eucharistic life of adoration also bears tremendous fruit in our own hearts and lives. We cannot spend time in the rays of His Eucharistic Presence without receiving His grace, His love, His mercy, His peace. As we gaze upon Him Face to fac, we are transformed little by little into a closer reflection of His divine image." I look forward to praying with you in the Presence of the Lord. Remember that the Sacrament can never be left alone, so we need two people at every hour. Augustine Maria of the Blessed Sacrament once said, "Yes, I am happy, perfectly happy; and do you wish to know where I find true happiness? At the feet of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. "Give yourself a gift and spend time with the greatest of all Gifts!

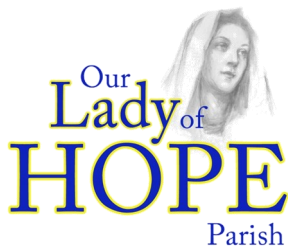

Saint's Corner: St. Agnes: Agnes lived in Rome in the 3rd century, when Christians were being persecuted. She was only 12 or 13 when she gave her life willingly for Christ. Agnes was beautiful and many men wanted to marry her. She refused them all and dedicated her life to remaining a virgin and a bride of Christ. She declared, "Christ is my bridegroom. He is the first to choose me. I shall be his alone." One of her suitors was so angry, he reported to the governor, she was a Christian. The governor summoned Agnes to the palace. He threatened her, describing the tortures they would use on her body. Agnes calmly looked at the instruments of torture. Next, the governor sent her to a house of prostitution to be tempted. All the men who saw her courage were afraid to touch her. One looked at her with lust and was struck blind. Agnes prayed for him and his sight was restored. The governor seeing that she could not be persuaded, ordered her condemned and executed. St. Ambrose wrote that she went to the place of execution more cheerfully than others go to their wedding.

Agnes is often pictured with a lamb as the name Agnes means lamb. The name is fitting as Agnes has the gentleness and innocence of a lamb.

Her Feast Day is January 21 and she is the patron saint of engaged couples, victims of sexual abuse, and gardeners.

Prayer: St Agnes, you refused to give up your faith; help us to be proud of our faith, to love it, to be strong in it, and to give witness to it daily. St. Agnes, patron saint of children, watch over the children of the world; keep them safe from harm; be with them in their hour
