A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Our Lady of Hope Parish has been blessed this past week. From Tuesday through Thursday, our parish celebrated the traditional Forty Hours or Hours of Eucharistic Adoration. Thank you to all who spent time in the Presence of Our Lord. What blessings for our parish and I am sure for everyone who sacrificed time to spend special moments that affects their eternal life. I would think that when we meet the Lord for our judgment, He will see this as one of the most important things that we could do with Him. On Friday, parishioners from our parish, thanks to our Knights of Columbus Council participated in the Annual March for Life in Washington, D.C. Some thought that the March might end with the Roe vs. Wade decision, returning the decision to destroy life back to the states. Of course, most states continue to allow the taking of human life in the womb (even preparing to sell do-it-yourself abortion pills at pharmacies), the push for euthanasia and the harmful effects of contraception. The world's march to depopulate continues. So, we go to Washington, not only in protest, but to rejoice in human life and to thank Almighty God for every breath. It is no wonder that we continue on a satanic death spiral when we see indications of an animosity against Christ. Recently, at the Mall of America, a man was told by a security guard to either take off his "Jesus Saves" t-shirt or he would need to vacate the mall. While ashamed of my sins, I have never regretted being ordained or being recognized as a priest. My friends, I am confident that you and I will need to defend our faith more and more over time. Spending time in prayer before Our Lord's Real Presence is what will give us the strength to not cave in to the satanic forces being unleashed upon the world. Jesus Christ be praised!

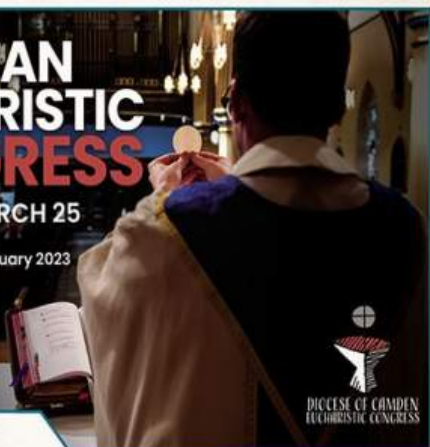

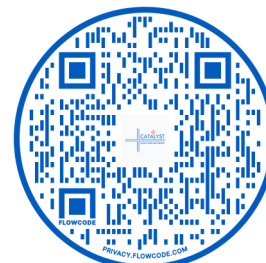

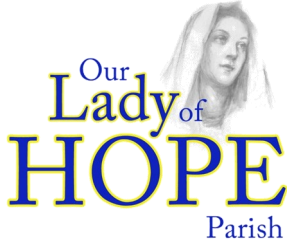

Saint's Corner: Thomas Aquinas was a large and brilliant man but he was also quiet and seldom spoke. His classmates called the "dumb ox". At the age of 5, Thomas' family sent him to be taught by the Benedictines in hope he would join their community and become an abbot. The Dominicans' life style of prayer and study attracted Thomas more and he joined them instead. His family was upset and shocked that he joined them since he was a nobleman and the friars were a group of poor men, so they captured him and held him captive in the family castle. Nothing could change his mind and they finally released him. Thomas first studied science but found he enjoyed theology more. He was known for his writings in philosophy and theology. He never forgot anything he read and could dictate to four secretaries at the same time on different subjects. Thomas prayed often and stated his gifts were given to him by God. While offering Mass in 1273, Thomas had a spiritual experience. After that he stopped writing completely. He stated after his experience, he looked at his writings like they were straw. A few months later, the Pope invited him to the Council of Lyons in France but Thomas died on the way there. Thomas had been an advisor to kings, a writer of masterpieces, a counselor to popes and a teacher of classics. Most of all, Thomas was servant of God. He is a Doctor of the Church and called "the angelic doctor" for his purity and knowledge. Thomas is the patron saint of Catholic schools, students, colleges, philosophers and theologians. Thomas was born in Italy and his feast day is January 28. A simple prayer to Saint Thomas: O Blessed Thomas, patron of schools, obtain for us from God an invincible faith, burning charity, a chaste life, and true knowledge, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

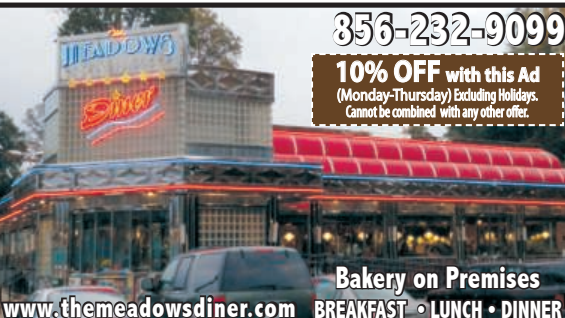

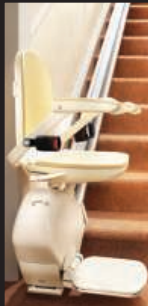
