Stewards Deny Self

“Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.” MATTHEW 5:3

The phrase “poor in spirit” can be confusing. Think of it in this sense – poor in spirit means depending on God’s providence and not depending on our own self-reliance. Being detached from earthy things (power, money, and comfort) and being attached to heavenly things (charity, sacrifice, and mercy). **Stewardship** is denying ourselves from satisfying our desires and helping others obtain their basic needs.

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

I recently mentioned at Holy Mass that we had a very blessed Forty Hours devotion filled with prayers before the Most Blessed Sacrament. Our diocese is launching another opportunity for the faithful to express and rekindle their love for the Lord's Real Presence. A diocesan event will take place on **March 25, 2023**. The Diocese of Camden is hosting a Eucharistic Congress at the Freedom Mortgage Pavilion on the Camden Waterfront. There is no cost for admission. The gates will open at 8:00 AM with Holy Mass commencing at 9:00 AM. Throughout the day there will be Eucharistic theme talks in both English and Spanish. These talks will be given by two missionaries who were assigned by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. The event will close at 3:00 PM. The Pavilion can hold 7,000 people and our bishop would like the fill the Pavilion with faithful parishioners from throughout our diocese. He wishes that every parish have at least 100 people attend. With the great love and devotion in our parish, I am certain that we can produce even more than that. There will be food stands available or people can bring their own lunches with them. There is plenty of parking at the Pavilion (once I know the price, I will let you know). In early March, the diocese will ask me how many tickets our parish needs. So, throughout the month of February, we will be encouraging participation at this historical and holy event. If you would like to get your name to us straightaway, you can call the office. Soon enough we will have sign-up sheets. We did get a bit of a taste of a diocesan wide Eucharistic event when we had the procession with the Most Blessed Sacrament on the Boardwalk in Atlantic City a few months ago. Many more people than expected came out, so I am confident that this event will be a specular event which will nourish our souls and lift our spirits. I, for one, would not miss it for the world. Pope Saint John Paul II said, "The Church and the world have great need of Eucharistic adoration. Jesus waits for us in this sacrament of love. Let us be generous with our time in going to meet Him in adoration and contemplation full of faith. And let us be ready to make reparation for the great faults and crimes of the world. May our adoration never cease." (*Dominicae Cena: Letter to Priests, Holy Thursday, 1980*). *Pope Saint John Paul II loved public demonstrations of faith and time and time again, he reminded us that such events express a mystery that is central to our faith. Please pray over your signing up for this historical event in our diocesan history and mark your calendars in big letters: JESUS DAY. Above all, we must express our love for Him, for our neighbor and request many graces for our own soul. It is so beautiful that the day chosen by our bishop, March 25th, is the Solemnity of the Annunciation. Our Blessed Mother said "yes" for us. May Our Queen call us to publicly proclaim, "We want Jesus!"*

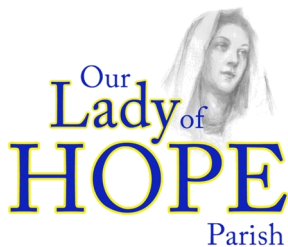

Saint's Corner: Saint Katharine of Drexel came from a family of wealth. Her father was an international banker and the family had a private railroad car. Her mother was a Quaker who died when Katharine was 5 months old. Her father married a Catholic woman. The Drexels even had a chapel in their home. Mr. Drexel prayed 30 minutes per day and Mrs. Drexel opened her home to the poor 3 days a week. When Mrs. Drexel became ill, Katharine took care of her for 3 years until her death. This experience made her think about values of life and becoming a nun. Then, after visiting the western part of the United States, she became concerned about the situation of the Native Americans. She had a chance meeting with Pope Leo XIII where she asked him to send more missionaries to Wyoming. He replied. "Why don't you become a missionary?" After she recovered from the shock of what the Pope said, she visited the chief of the Sioux and began helping the missions. She joined the Sisters of Mercy in Pittsburgh to make a 2 year novitiate. In 1891 she made her vows as the first Sister of the Blessed Sacrament. Her order was dedicated to sharing the Gospel and Eucharist among Native Americans and blacks. The old Drexel summer home became the Sisters first convent. After 3 1/2 years, Mother Drexel and the other Sisters opened a boarding school in Santa Fe, New Mexico. She spent her life and her inheritance of twelve million dollars on her work. She has established over 50 missions for Native Americans in 16 states, a systems of Catholic schools for blacks, 40 mission centers and 23 rural schools. She spoke out against racism and other injustices and made both Church and the country more aware of the needs of the poor. Mother Drexel's greatest educational achievement was founding Xavier University in New Orleans, the first university for blacks in the United States. Mother Drexel had a heart attack at the age of 77 and was forced to retire. She spent the rest of her days praying in a room at the convent. She died at 96 years old.

Her feast day is March 13th. She is the patron saint of racial injustice and philanthropists.

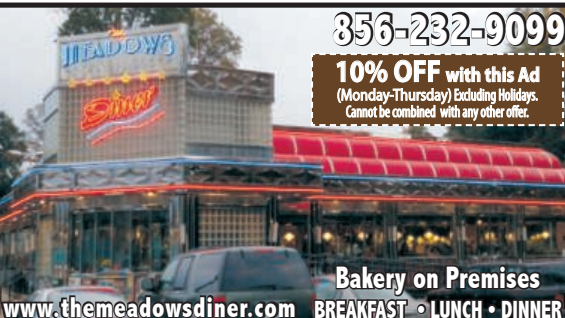

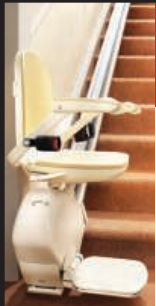
