A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

I pray that everyone is doing well and that February will see everyone preparing for the high season of Lent which is right around the corner. To update on some of the temporal realities of our parish, we hope to have the window replaced that was damaged a few weeks ago. The window needed to be ordered and cut as it is a large, unique sized window. We also will soon have new LED light bulbs in the lighting in the church. We have a growing number of bulbs blowing out and in order to put in the new bulbs, there needs to be scaffolding. We also added new sinks and vanities in the church bathrooms. We still have to be on top of the plumbing situation as wipes are being flushed which has caused plumbing blockage. Pardon my speaking of such matters, but I want to keep you informed. A lift is not always possible in a church our size, but this should be taken care of in the next few weeks. We have been doing some work in the hall, namely, the Saints John, Matthew, Luke and McGivney rooms have all received new flooring and lots of new paint has been applied including the bathrooms. Next year, we plan on tackling the main hall floor as it still contained the lines when it was used for basketball. Thank you so much for taking care of our spiritual home dedicated to the great Saint Agnes. The size of our church requires a lot of attention and anything we can all do to care for it is important. If everyone will indulge me in a few requests: please do not leave tissues, water bottles and bulletins in the pews. There are a lot of seats and it's a lot to go around the church and collect everything (nothing like having to collect a used tissue or mask!). If everyone could put the hymnals properly in their racks before leaving Holy Mass with the page ribbons placed inside the books. Finally, if for some reason one brings one of the plastic red chairs out to the church from the meeting room, please put your chair back into the meeting room. Our church has a lot of pews with plenty of room, but if you need a chair, please put it back. This would be so helpful as I need to carry all the chairs back after the Masses. Thank you so much for your consideration. These are not major problems, but I thought I would bring them to everyone's attention. Finally, more silence in the church would be most appreciated. I often hear people ask me what can be done to stop people from talking so loudly in the church before the Mass. People have said that I long to be able to pray and yet, people openly chat at quite the volume. It is always good for us to assess and regroup, especially as we prepare for Lent. The House of God is a very sacred space that should be kept like no other space in our lives. Michael Brown said, "There is no separation between the Gospel and culture, between how we live in society and how we live in our private lives, between the Lordship of Jesus inside the four walls of a church building and outside that building." As I ask to help to keep our church building orderly, even more so do I call us all to keep our soul, a temple of the Holy Spirit in good order.

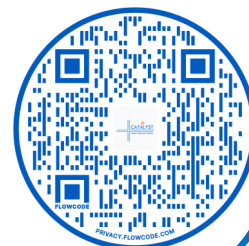

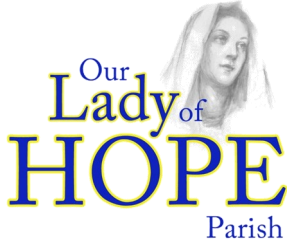

To all candidates making Confirmation in 2023, two videos will be sent out this week. Please watch these videos as they will be discussed at your meetings on March 20, 2023 and March 27, 2023. Please make sure all paperwork is filled out properly. Make sure pages are signed that require a signature. Make sure the Saint you choose is the same as the Saint you write about in the packet. Make sure to have your letters for the Bishop and Father and they are signed as well. Sometime this is a missed step. Last but not least, make sure your sponsor has their letter of eligibility. Saint's Corner: Saint Blaise was a Bishop and a martyr. He was a physician before he was ordained a priest. He became bishop of Sabaste (now central Turkey). During a period of persecution, he fled to a cave where he lived as a hermit. It is said that he cured and tames wild animals there. One day hunters discovered him and took him to the governor, who sentenced him to torture and death. About 400 years after his death, many stories began to be told about Blaise, and he became a popular saint, especially in France and Germany. One legend says that while Blaise was in prison, a mother brought him her small child who was choking on a fishbone that was stuck in his throat. Blaise prayed over the child and he was healed. Every year on St. Blaise's feast, two candles tied with ribbon in the shape of an X are used to bless throats. In the prayer, the church prays that those blessed may be delivered from diseases of the throat and other illness. Candles are used because another story says Blaise was kept in a dark prison and a woman secretly brought him candles and food. His feast day is February 3rd. He is the protector of throat diseases, wild animals, wax makers and wool combers.

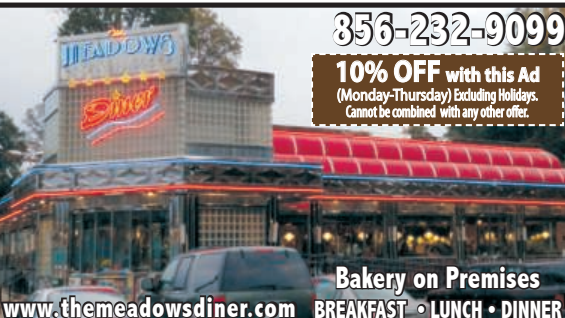

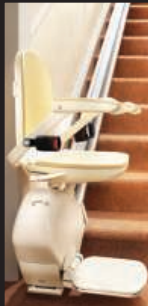
