## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

Once again, we are kicking off another year of the House of Charity/The Bishop's Annual Appeal. This campaign has been renamed the South Jersey Catholic Ministries Appeal, but the need is as acute as ever. Our goal is definitely a lofty one, but we pray in the name of the Lord that we can reach our goal in order to carry out the work of Jesus in our midst. Our goal this year is \$210,200 as assigned by the Diocese. Even more important than the goal itself, is what your generosity accomplishes in the lives of so many. The theme this year is *For the Life of the World*. The film that we will watch at all the Masses shows us how your gift will reach so many people. Always close to my heart is the assistance you offer to our future priests, who are so brave in answering the call from Our Lord to possibly serve as a priest, a servant of God. Always remember, "no priest, no Eucharist." The annual campaign is your way of doing something "beautiful for God" (Mother Teresa) and therefore, we are called to be "houses of charity." 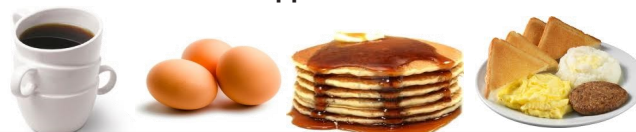

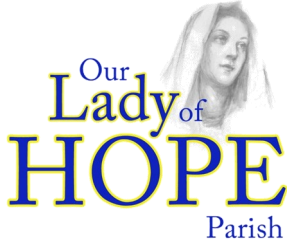

#### Saint's Corner:

St. Peter Damian: Peter Damian knew hardships. He was orphaned as a young child and was adopted by an older brother. This brother treated him harshly, gave him little to eat and used him as a worker but with no pay. Another brother, a priest named Damian, rescued him and made sure he received a good education. Peter added this brother's name to his own. Peter became a successful teacher, and then was ordained to the priesthood. He entered a Benedictine monastery, where two monks lived in each small hermitage. It was a strict, demanding life and Peter devoted himself totally to it. He was known for his fasting, acts of penance, and long hours of prayer. He was eventually elected abbot of the monastery. As abbot, Peter began reforming the practices and rules of the order. He believed that only by going back to the original spirit and purpose of the Benedictine order could the monks really witness to others and praise God. Many candidates were drawn to the monastery, and eventually Peter started five other religious houses. Peter's talents and zeal were not confined to the monastery. He was made cardinal and Bishop of Ostia. Soon he was called on by the Church to settle disputes, attend synods, and fight abuses. Aware of many problems of the time, Peter knew the best way to reform society was to reform its leaders. He devoted much of his energy to helping the leaders as well as the clergy. Through his letters, biographies, sermons, stories and poems, he encouraged others to restore discipline to their lives. Once he even persuaded the king of Germany not to divorce his wife. Throughout all his travels and his diplomatic missions, Peter Damian remained a monk at heart. Though drawn to prayer and solitude, he served the Church as he was asked and as best he could. He was declared a Doctor of the Church. His feast day is February 21. Peter Damian is considered the spiritual patron for leprosy and outcasts. Father Damien Day, April 15th the day of his death, is also a minor statewide holiday in Hawaii.

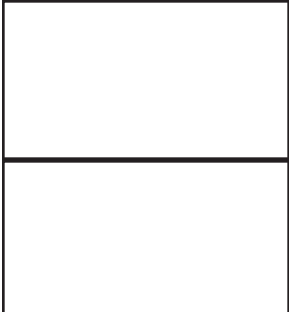
