A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

We know that the Roman Catholic Church is in a crisis in that the majority of those baptized Catholics do not understand the true majesty of the Real Presence, the Holy Eucharist confectioned at the Holy Mass. Saint Padre Pio once said, "It would be easier for the world to exist without the sun than without the Holy Mass." He would also go on to say, "At times during the Mass I am consumed by the fire of Divine Love. My face seems to burn." Such love! If the Catholic faith is to stay strong, we must love Him and adore Him in the Most Blessed Sacrament. We need to bolster our own devotion to the Lord. I hope that we will have a great representation at the Diocesan Eucharistic Congress in Camden on March 25th. If you have not signed up, please feel free to do so. I am sure that it will be a moving and faith-filled event. The sign-up sheets are in the vestibule of our church or you can sign up online. We know that there is great persecution of true Catholics in China to this day. In his autobiography entitled *Treasure in Clay*, Archbishop Fulton Sheen writes about a true incident that took place in China. He wrote, "A priest had just begun Mass when Communists entered and arrested him and made him a prisoner . . . Shortly after his imprisonment, the Communists opened the tabernacle, threw the Hosts on the floor and stole the Sacred Vessels . . . About three o'clock one morning, he saw a child who had been at the morning Mass open a window, climb in, come to the sanctuary floor, get down on both knees, press her tongue to the Host to give herself Holy Communion . . . Every single night she came at the same time until there was only one Host left. As she pressed her tongue to receive the Body of Christ, a shot rang out. A Communist soldier had seen her. It proved to be her Viaticum." Viaticum is when one receives Holy Communion for the last time before one dies. If we only truly realized the gift we have as Catholics nothing would keep us from receiving Him; from adoring Him. We continue to have our times for confession. Remember, the Church continues to teach that if one is in mortal sin, then receiving Holy communion in that state is a sacrilege. The more we spend time adoring Him, the more reverently we will receive Holy Communion. We will not grab the Sacred Host and pop It in our mouth. We will, lovingly, receive Him on the tongue or allow the Sacred Host to be placed on our hand (one hand beneath the other). We will be in hushed awe whenever in the church where the Tabernacle containing the Lord's Presence resides. May the Eucharistic Congress envelope our diocese with the fragrance of God's love and change our lukewarm hearts into furnaces of love for Jesus! To quote Saint Peter Julian Eymard, "The Eucharist is everything, because from the Eucharist, everything is."

Saint's Corner:

Saint Casimir, prince of Poland, was an exception to other princes of the times. While other princes were found in castles and palaces, he was found with the poor. He was nicknamed "bother and defender of the poor". Much of his character and strength came from his teacher, John Dlugosz. John was a Polish historian who saw in Casimir the natural gift of leadership and idealism. He instilled in Casimir a desire to love God's law and to live by his conscience. By the time Casimir was thirteen, his goodness was so well know that nobles in Hungary, who were not happy with their king, wanted Casimir as ruler. Casimir's father sent him with an army to take over another country. Pay was low for the soldiers, and many deserted. Casimir realized that the enemy outnumbered them and the battle would be a waste of their lives. He also learned that the pope had asked his father not to attack. Therefore, Casimir returned home with no kingdom. His father was furious and disgraced. He banished his son to a nearby castle for three months. There Casimir studied and prayed. He resolved never to be involved in war again and to govern only by peaceful means. He also decided never to marry. This frustrated his parents because he refused to marry the daughter of Emperor Frederick !!. While his father was on tour in Lithuania, Casimir governed Poland for a short time. He dies of lung disease at the age of twenty-six. Casimir loved Our Lady very much a every day repeated the hymn, "Daily, Daily Sing to Mary". He asked this song be buried with him. Casimir saw that his first duty was to God. It is good to pray to know our responsibilities to God and to be strong enough to fulfill them. He became known for his piety, devotion to God and generosity towards the sick and poor. Casimir is known as "special Saint for the youth". Casimir is also known as the Saint of Poland and Lithuania. His feast day is March 4. Casimir and all the Saints, in Thy mercy, grant us health and peace, that after all adversity and error is removed, Thy Church may serve Thee in freedom and safety, through the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Our Lord, Who liveth and reigneth with Thee in the union of the Holy Ghost world without end. Amen.

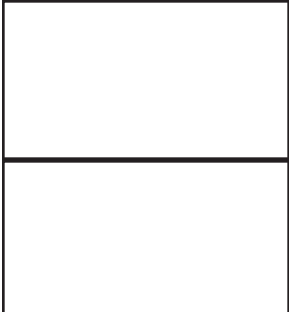
