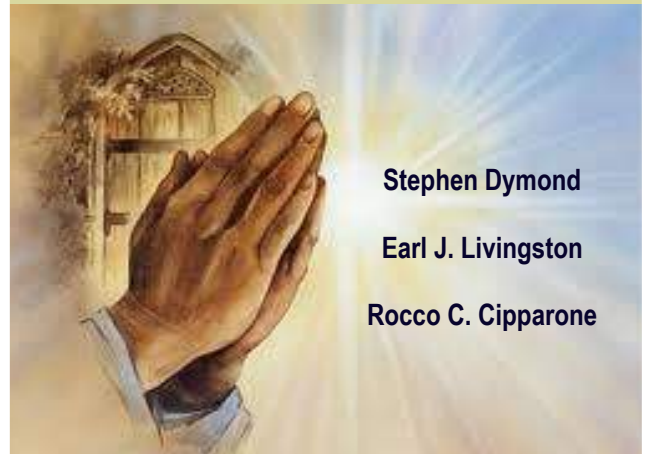

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

“In the *Roman Missal* we find the instruction, ‘In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from [the fifth] Sunday [of Lent] may be observed. Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord’s Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.’” The idea is to close off our senses in order to heighten them for the celebration of Easter. The veils are not meant to be covering the images forever. Is this not what our life is like in this “veil of tears” as we pray in the hymn *Salve Regina*? We cannot see heaven and we are reminded that the sin and darkness of this fallen world keep us from seeing His glory and His reflection in the saints. We might veil our statues at home as well or put away sacred images until the end of Good Friday. This is, in a way, a type of fasting. I worked in an Italian restaurant when I was in high school. Every day, Italian food, washing the dishes, mopping the floor and smelling the same smell every day. After a while I no longer longed or appreciated the savory Italian dishes. I grew to temporarily loathe them (thank God that did not last!). We have so much and our appreciation of things can be dulled. Do without and then appreciate their goodness. We have suppressed the *Gloria* during Lent and have not sung the alleluia. The hand bells will stop ringing at the Mass on Holy Thursday night and be replaced by a clunky, wooden clacker. All this to cleanse our senses, if only for a short time, in order to see the revealing of the glory of God. We hear Simeon say to the Holy Virgin and Saint Joseph in the Temple when he takes the baby Jesus into his arms, “My own eyes have seen the salvation which You have prepared in the sight of every people: a light to reveal You to the nations and the glory of Your people Israel.” (Luke 2:30-32). We have so many beautiful customs in the Church and the veiling of statues is one of them. I remember a number of years ago, someone said to me when I veiled the statues, “Oh, you are so old fashioned!” I could only say, “Well, thank you for the compliment...” Speaking of a veil, N.T. Wright said, “[Jesus] is, at the moment, present with us, but hidden behind that invisible veil which keeps heaven and earth apart, and which we pierce in those moments, such as prayer, the sacraments, the reading of scripture, and our work with the poor, when the veil seems particularly thin. But one day the veil will be lifted; earth and heaven will be one; Jesus will be personally present, and every knee shall bow at his name; creation will be renewed; the dead will be raised; and God’s new world will at last be in place, full of new prospects and possibilities.” Uh oh, am I being “old fashioned” again?

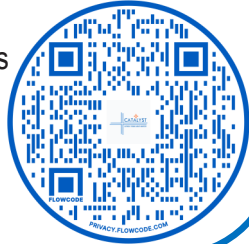

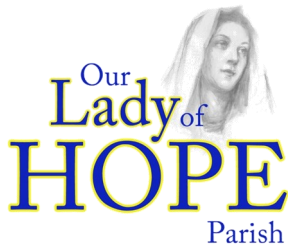

Saint's Corner:

Saint Peregrine: Saint Peregrine Laziosi was born in 1260, the only son of an affluent family in Forlì, in northern Italy. At that time Forlì was part of the Papal States. Peregrine's family supported the anti-papal faction. In 1667 the residents of Forlì were under interdict.^[1] Philip Benizi, Prior General of the Friar Servants of Saint Mary, was sent to try to reconcile the divided community. While trying to preach in Forlì, Philip was heckled and struck by the 18-year-old Laziosi. He was driven from the city with insults and violence. Laziosi repented and asked Philip for forgiveness. Benizi received him with kindness. The moment had a profound effect on Laziosi. Filled with remorse, he began to pray more and to channel his energies into good works. A few years later, he joined the Servites in Siena and went on to be ordained a priest. After some years, he was sent back to Forlì, where he founded a new Servite house there and became well known for his preaching and holiness as well as his devotion to the sick and poor. It is said that he miraculously multiplied grain and wine during a severe shortage in his area. People took to calling him the "Angel of Good Counsel", so grateful were they for his wise advice so freely given. One of the special penances he imposed on himself was to stand whenever it was not necessary to sit. When tired, he would support himself on a choir stall. At the age of 60, he developed an infection in his right leg. His condition deteriorated to the point that the physician decided to amputate his leg. The night before the operation, Laziosi spent time praying before a fresco of the Crucifixion in the chapter room. He fell into a deep trance-like sleep and seemed to see Jesus descend from the cross to touch his leg. The following day, the doctor arrived to perform the amputation, and, finding no sign of the cancer, news of the miraculous cure spread throughout the town. This only increased the people's regard for Laziosi. He died of a fever on 1 May 1345, at the age of 85. An extraordinary number of people from the town and countryside honored his death. Some of the sick who came were healed, which was attributed to his intercession. His feast day is May 4. He is the patron saint of cancer and other illnesses.
