## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

We now enter the holiest week of the year. Our palms will be held aloft in celebration of the Lord's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. This has been a beautiful Lent in the parish. I was so pleased with the turnout for the Soup and Scripture and for the Stations of the Cross. Many are spending more time in prayer which is so evident as we see the fruit. I am so grateful to all who are using this time to grow in grace and to realize that without the Lord, we have nothing. The schedule for Holy Week is in the bulletin and on our parish website. Please consider coming out for all of the blessed Masses and services during Holy Week and into the high feast of Easter. We will have adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the chapel on Holy Thursday night until Midnight. We will pray from the end of the Mass of the Lord's Supper until the prayer of Compline which will be at 11:30 PM on Holy Thursday. Our Lord said to His disciples, "Could no one stay awake for one hour with me?" Another tradition is visiting an odd number of churches. One could visit Saint Jude Church, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mater Ecclesiae, etc. We watch with our Lord keeping vigil in the garden with Him. At the Easter Vigil, we will speak of light...the Light of Christ when the Easter Candle is lighted from the Blessed Fire and processed into the church. We will sing, "Christ our Light!" The answer will be "Thanks be to God!" The faithful will rejoice in the darkness as the Light of Christ dawns upon us. This year, Bishop Sullivan will be the celebrant of the Easter Vigil in our parish. How blessed to have our chief shepherd with us on Saturday night. The Lord has blessed our parish in so many ways and I join my brother priests in rejoicing with Our Risen Lord for you. I take no credit, but only give glory to God and thank you for your generosity and above for the sacrifices you make for your parish. God is doing great things in our parish, and I am sure it is due to your love for the Real Presence and for your devotion to Our Mother Mary. It is very edifying. I am also aware of the pain of those, who due to health conditions or fears, cannot come to Mass and must miss terribly receiving Our Lord in Holy Communion Even though you may not be with us in person due to illness, you are in my thoughts and prayers when I offer the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Let us all be one in prayer. We must meditate on the powerful events that lead to the celebration of the Risen Lord. In the meantime, Happy Palm Sunday! Hosanna to the Son of David!

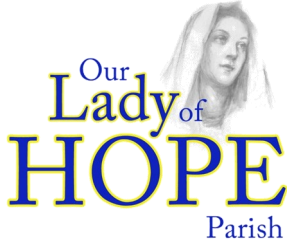

### Saint's Corner:

**Saint Angela** Saint Angela Merici was born in Northern Italy. Her parents died when she was a young girl and she went to live with her Uncle. She joined the Franciscan Third Order, a group of people who try to live a life of prayer and good works in the spirit of St. Francis of Assisi. Angela had a vision in which she was told she would form a society of virgins in Brescia. Ten years later Angela was invited to stay with a family in Brescia whose sons had died. In Brescia she saw many girls were not educated. She began to teach them about the faith. Angela knew that a Christian world and a Christian society must grow from Christian families. "Convert the woman and one converts the family", she said. At fifty-seven years of age, Angela formed a religious group (oldest women's order in the Catholic Church) of twenty-eight women who thought as she did. She called her group the company of St. Ursula. St Ursula, an English queen and martyr, was the patroness of universities and a leader of woman. At that time women in religious communities were not allowed to leave their convents except in emergencies. Angela's Sisters received permission from Rome to live in their own homes and do works of mercy, especially teaching. They wore lay clothes and met once a month for a day of prayer and discussion. Forty years later, St. Charles Borromeo asked the Sisters to become a religious community and live in a convent. They began to wear habits and were known as the Ursulines. St. Angela's example of serving God in an active manner has been followed by many groups of religious women who teach, nurse, and otherwise minister to others. Her feast day is: January 27.
