A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Easter to everyone and Blessed Divine Mercy Sunday! Now is the time to savor the mystery of the Risen Lord Who made possible that those who follow Him and live Him can, through His mercy, go to heaven. Our parish had a beautiful Lent and celebration of the mysteries of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord. We began, what was weeks ago, our Lent with the reception of burnt palm on our foreheads. We were entreated to change our lives and seek ways to be better disciples of the Lord Jesus. Every Friday, during Lent, we had an opportunity for meditation, whether it was at Soup and Scripture or the final Friday of Lent, when we had a blessed time in the Real Presence of the Lord. Thank you to all the various ministries who provided various meatless soups for the five Fridays that we meditated on the Holy Wounds. I was so happy to see so many participate each week in praying the Stations of the Cross in the church. It was a very special night on the final Friday of Lent when many spent at least two hours praising the Lord before the Most Blessed Sacrament and having an opportunity to have some moments with the Holy Eucharist up close. Our Palm Sunday saw many more people at the Masses than the last number of years and we were once again treated to a very enjoyable breakfast hosted by the Knights of Columbus. Good job men, vivat Jesus! The Holy Triduum or three days before Easter were so prayerful and I am so grateful to all who participated and who helped during these days to enhance our celebrations so powerfully. I express my gratitude to Father March who kept everything on target and who made himself available on every level. Thank you, Father Antony and Father March, for hearing hours and hours (without exaggeration) of confessions. This sacrament is essential to anyone who is serious about Lent and who desires to convert continuously to the Lord Jesus. Thank you so much Mike Alibrando for all the planning and carrying out of the numerous details that go into the Triduum and to all the sacristans who worked so hard to prepare the altar at the Masses. Our choir, under the direction of John Wernega, were fantastic and I know that they worked hard to prepare for these blessed celebrations. Thank you to Ted Kiefer and the cantors who led us in prayer at numerous times. Norberto Cruz, muchas gracias for the powerful outdoor Stations of the Cross as performed by the Saint Jude community. Muchos personas este año! Gracias a Dios! For all the many details Norberto that you carried out these days, Dios lo bendiga. I am very grateful to our Scouts for building the fire for the Easter Vigil. I love that we do not have some little flame in a tin plate, but we have a real fire that shatters the darkness! The Vigil is always so special, but this year we were very blessed as we saw eight people enter the One, True, Faith at the hands of Bishop Sullivan. The Bishop chose to come to our parish this year and he made what is already an extraordinary celebration, a memorable and prayerful moment in the life of Our Lady of Hope Parish. I rejoice in taking this opportunity to review these great moments in our parish life. Now, we continue to sing Alleluia whenever possible, and we meditate on the Lord's triumph over sin and death. Lord, we thank You for everything and we love and esteem You. Thank you for Your Passion, Death and Resurrection. An anonymous person once said, "It wasn't nails that held Him to the Cross, but His love for you and me." Jesus proved how much He loves us...now it our turn to prove how much we love Him.

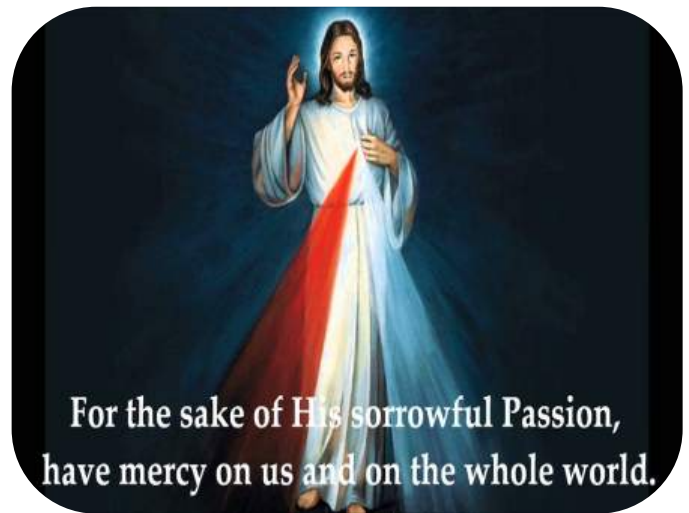

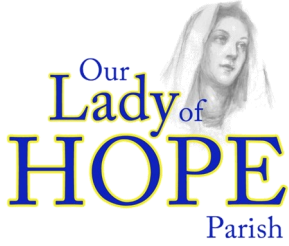

Saint's Corner:

Saint Bridget: A Christian Mystic is a person who has received a special gift of prayer from God. Because this type of prayer is a free gift to a person whom God chooses, no one can control it or earn it. This mystical prayer, an experience of a special union with God in love, was given to Bridget of Sweden. She often had visions of Christ's passion. However, like other Christian mystics, Bridget was also very practical and down-to-earth in living out the Gospel of Jesus. It was said, "she had a laughing face." Bridget was born into the family of a wealthy landowner in Sweden. When she was thirteen, she married and became an excellent wife and mother. One of her eight children, Catherine of Sweden, became a canonized saint. Once Bridget was invited to become the chief lady-in-waiting to the queen. While she was there, she encouraged the queen and king to live holy lives. After her husband's death, she became a member of the Third Order of St. Francis. She then founded the Order of the Most Holy Savior for men and women to the culture of Scandinavia. The members became known as the Bridgettines. Bridget showed loving concern for the poor and the sick, and many people came to her for help. She also did a great deal of penance in the seventy years of her life. Bridget made many pilgrimages around Italy and even to the Holy Land. She spent her last years in Rome. Like Catherine of Siena, she urged the pope to leave Avignon in France and return to Rome, the center of Christianity. She suffered debts, opposition to reform, shipwreck, and her son's death. She died in Rome, ending a busy, holy life. Bridget was a wife, mother, founder and advisor to the pope. Her feast day is July 23 and she is the Patron saint of Sweden and dairy workers.
