A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

We begin this May in a way one would never have thought possible. This is the time to run outdoors and to plan for graduations, the Phillies season, picnics and so much more as we would plan our summer vacations. Will we go to the beach or get on a plane any time soon? We always look for ways to brighten our days. For me, this month contains so much that I love: it is the month of the Queen of the May, the Blessed Virgin Mary; it starts off with the feast of Saint Joseph, the patron saint of workers and my name saint; it is the month that I was first ordained to the Diaconate and then to the Holy Priesthood; it is normally the month of First Communions and May Crownings; and is the month where flowers and trees blossom in abundance (although we allergy sufferers might see that one as a mixed bag!). I hope it is a blessed month for you as well. Our growing grotto continues to be visited by numerous people every day. It is so great to see. We will have Holy Mass celebrated at our grotto, rather than in our church on Saturday, May 6th, at 9:00 AM. Our Lady will also be crowned during this Mass. Too often, people see devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary as an “extra.” It is something sweet and nice to have. In reality, she is so much more, and it is one of the reasons it would be unthinkable for me not to be Catholic. Without her loving presence, so much would be missing. Saint Maximilian Kolbe once said, “Never be afraid of loving the Blessed Virgin too much. You can never love her more than Jesus did.” At this point in my life, I cannot remember not loving the Holy Mother of God. What joy she brings when we see a statue, an icon or painting of the Blessed Lady. The Holy Rosary is a chain of powerful love that calls us to meditate over and over the mysteries that make up our holy faith. Saint Mother Teresa always had a Rosary in her hand and Saint John Paul II declared the Rosary as his favorite prayer. His secretary once said that if John Paul II was to stay on schedule at an event, do not let him pass a statue of Our Lady for he will stop and pray. The prayer might go on and no one could budge him! Pope Francis said to the people of Poland about Our Lady of Jasna Gora: “She is a true mother, with a marked face, a mother who suffers because she truly carries in her heart the problems in our lives...She is a close mother, who never loses us from her sight; she is a tender mother, who holds our hand on the path of daily life.” Yes, we know that suffering can bear fruit and Our Mother Mary teaches this to us in a profound way. If you want to really know the Lord Jesus, we go to Our Mother who, only second to Our Heavenly Father, knows Her Son. Yes, let us increase love for the glorious patroness of our parish, Our Lady of Hope.

A strong sense of community within our Church and neighborhood protects mental health through shared support, resources, and joy. Our emotional health paired with our physical health make us "healthy." Stress is normal for our bodies; however, we are generally able to recover from short periods of stress. But stress that continues over a long period of time places more strain to our health. Mental stress can impact the immune system in many different ways and increase physical illness.

Spending time in nature is linked to many positive mental health outcomes, including improved focus, lower stress, better mood, reduced risk of developing mental health conditions, and a sense of connection to yourself, community, and purpose. Being around nature doesn't have to mean hiking in a forest. It can be walking in a park, bringing a plant inside, or sitting in your backyard.

The Weekend of May 13/14, at all masses, Rev. Raju Pilla will be speaking about the works and the needs of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum in India. Trivandrum has about 270,000 Catholics. 90% of the people belongs to fishermen community, majority of whom depends on fishing for their livelihood. 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in our communities. The Archdiocese depends on outside contributions to support its clergy, seminarians, catechists and to continue its humanitarian projects such as the homes for the orphans, aged and destitute, which provide food, shelter, health care, and education. Recently with the horrific effects from the pandemic as well as the cyclone "Tauktae" in 2021, hundreds of families are homeless. Monsoon sea-erosion each year, destroys several homes of the fishermen who live near the sea and make a living from fishing. The Archdiocese is still struggling to recover from the crippling effects of financial devastation caused by the pandemic lockdowns. We humbly request your generous contribution to the second collection to assist the most vulnerable with food, shelter, and clothing. Your sacrifice for the Missions is deeply appreciated. 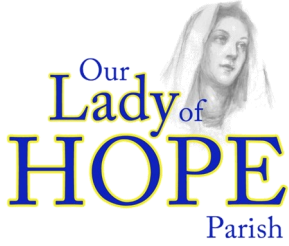

Saint's Corner:

Saint Mary Magdalen de Pazzi: Catherine of de Pazzi was born in Florence, Italy. At the age of nine she was taught how to meditate and pray by the family chaplain. Around the same time is also when de' Pazzi began practicing mortification of the flesh through self-flagellation, wearing a barbed metal cilice, and wearing a home-made crown of thorns. She received her First Communion at the then-early age of 10 and made a vow of virginity the same year. She experienced her first ecstasy when she was only twelve, in her mother's presence. From then on, she continued to exhibit what she considered to be many varied mystical experiences. Her family was quite wealthy, and it looked like Catherine would grow up to be a woman of high society, but she surprised everyone by becoming a Carmelite nun at the age of 16. She took the name Mary Magdalene and was soon leading a life of deep prayer, humility and penance. For years she experienced the gift of ecstasy, union with God. She was appointed novice mistress and then superior. She was given the ability to read sisters' thoughts, a gift she used only for the good of her nuns. Not only did she renew her order, she wrote to Bishops and even the Pope, encouraging them to reform the church. For five years before her death, St Mary Magdalene de Pazzi suffered greatly. For three years from a severe illness along with great spiritual dryness. Prayer brought her no comfort. Everything looked horrible to her, and she had terrible temptations. During this painful period, she was heroically cheerful and kind to everyone. It was her deep prayer, her humble use of the talents God had given her, and great charity she practiced toward the other nuns that made this quiet nun such a wonderful saint. Her feast day is May 25 and she is the patron saint of Perfumers.

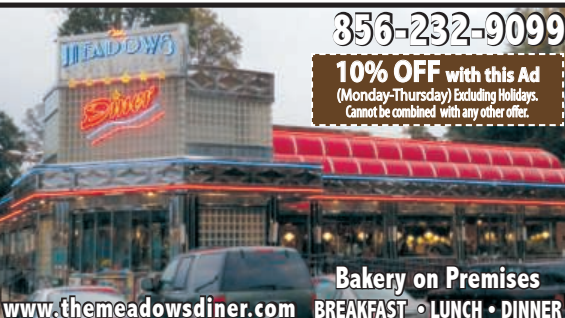
