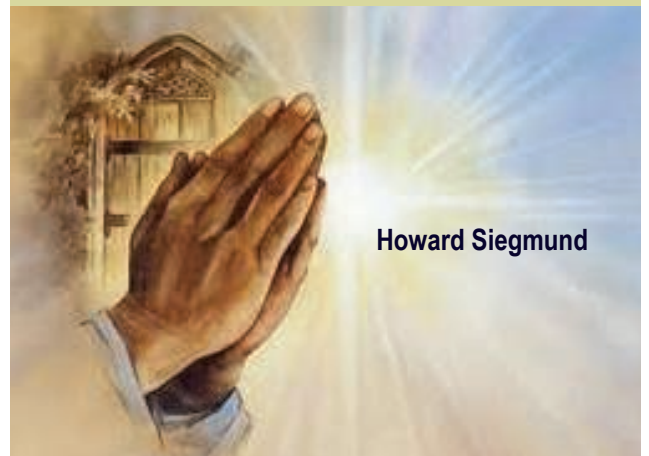

A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

May is one of my favorite months because it is dedicated to Our Lady, Mary, Queen of the May; May 1st is dedicated to Saint Joseph, Patron of Workers and it is the month in which I was ordained to the Holy Priesthood. On May 28, 1988, I was ordained as a priest at the hands of Bishop George Guilfoyle in Saint Joseph, the Pro cathedral. I cannot believe that it will be 35 years of service as a priest of Jesus Christ. Saint Jose Maria Escriva wrote, "Custody of the heart. That priest used to pray: "Jesus, may my poor heart be an enclosed garden; may my poor heart be a paradise where you live; may my Guardian Angel watch over it with a sword of fire and use it to purify every affection before it comes into me. Jesus, with the divine seal of your Cross, seal my poor heart." (*The Forge*, 412). It is so important to pray for priests as the devil wants to destroy the souls of the shepherds. He does not care about the priest himself but wants to pain Our Savior and to scatter the sheep. A good priest can do an infinite amount of good and this is only if He reflects the Lord Jesus instead of Himself. I recently had a young priest say to me, "I love being a priest!" I can still say, 35 years later, I too love being a priest. Dear Lord, please never let that young priest's heart grow cold! We need good priests and I invite you to pray for men to answer the call of God to consider the Priesthood from our parish. We are working on beginning a group to encourage and pray for vocations to the Holy Priesthood, the Diaconate and Religious life from Our Lady of Hope Parish. I expect the fruit of so many prayers uttered before the Real Presence and with the great love for the Blessed Virgin Mary, that we will have men answer the call or at least to ask the Lord, "Do you want me Lord to be Your priest?" I know that if a priest did not ask me if I ever thought about the Priesthood, it would not have crossed my mind. I have also had the privilege of working with cardinals, bishops and above all, very good priests. I know that I have been privileged and I so want this happiness to be for other men. If I had the chance to choose another vocation, it is unthinkable that I could say "yes" to anything else. The Priesthood has never disappointed me. Are there crosses? Of course, but it is absurd to think that any of us can avoid the Cross, especially if we want to truly be followers of Christ. The Priesthood is all about love: love for God and love for neighbor in an intense, sacrificial way. Father Pedro Arrupe, S.J. wrote, "Nothing is more practical than finding God, that is, than falling in love in a quite absolute, final way. What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination, will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the morning, what you will do with your evenings, how you will spend your weekends, what you read, who you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in Love and it will decide everything." Everyone desires a love affair, what could be more profound than living and serving in the love of Jesus as a priest!

A strong sense of community within our Church and neighborhood protects mental health through shared support, resources, and joy. But stress that continues over a long period of time places more strain to our health. Mental stress can impact the immune system in many different ways and increase physical illness.

Spending time in nature is linked to many positive mental health outcomes, including improved focus, lower stress, better mood, reduced risk of developing mental health conditions, and a sense of connection to yourself, community, and purpose. Being around nature doesn't have to mean hiking in a forest. It can be walking in a park, bringing a plant inside, or sitting in your backyard.

"Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your mind in Christ Jesus." – Philippians 4: 6-7.

NEXT WEEKEND, at all masses, Rev. Raju Pilla will be speaking about the works and the needs of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum in India. Trivandrum has about 270,000 Catholics. 90% of the people belongs to fishermen community, majority of whom depends on fishing for their livelihood. 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in our communities. The Archdiocese depends on outside contributions to support its clergy, seminarians, catechists and to continue its humanitarian projects such as the homes for the orphans, aged and destitute, which provide food, shelter, health care, and education. Recently with the horrific effects from the pandemic as well as the cyclone "Tauktae" in 2021, hundreds of families are homeless. Monsoon sea-erosion each year, destroys several homes of the fishermen who live near the sea and make a living from fishing. The Archdiocese is still struggling to recover from the crippling effects of financial devastation caused by the pandemic lockdowns. We humbly request your generous contribution to the second collection to assist the most vulnerable with food, shelter, and clothing. Your sacrifice for the Missions is deeply appreciated. 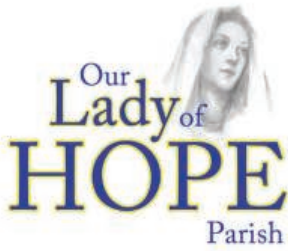

Saint's Corner:

St. Martin: Saint Martin had been a lector and a deacon in his church as a youth. He was elected Pope in 649 when a heresy that denied that Jesus has a human will was splitting the Church. Emperor Constant II forbade any more discussion about the matter. Pope Martin, fearing that the truth about Christ would not be taught, called a council. This council published an explanation of the doctrine of the two natures in Christ. It condemned the patriarchs (the bishops) of Constantinople and said that the emperor had been misguided by his advisors. Angered by the council, the emperor had Martin arrested and taken on a long, difficult voyage from Rome to Constantinople. The pope was given little food, was forbidden to wash, even in cold water, for forty-seven days, and was denied all help. When Martin arrived in Constantinople, he was insulted by the people and accused in an unjust trial, not for defending the faith but for being a traitor. The emperor ordered Martin publicly stripped of his episcopal robes, which were ripped from top to bottom. The Church elected a new pope. Worn out, Martin wrote to a friend that had been abandoned by all, even in the Church of Rome. The verdict of death was changed to exile when the repentant, dying patriarch of Constantinople wrote to the emperor on Martin's behalf. Martin was then exiled to Crimea, where he died, neglected and forgotten by his friends and relatives. Before he died he wrote that he prayed for the safety of the faithful in Rome and especially for the guidance of the new pope. Martin is the last pope to be honored as a martyr. He died two years later in exile in the year 656, a martyr who stood up for the right of the Church to establish doctrine even in the face of imperial power. His feast day is April 13. He is known for truth telling and he is the patron saint of social justice, racial harmony, and mixed-race people.
