A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

We are privileged to honor the Body and Blood of Our Savior Jesus Christ. This feast day is affectionately known as the Feast of Corpus Christi. Saint Cyril wrote of the Blessed Sacrament:

Godhead here in hiding, whom I do adore
Masked by these bare shadows, shape and nothing more,
See, Lord, at thy service low lies here a heart
Lost, all lost in wonder at the God thou art.
Seeing, touching, tasting are in thee deceived;
How says trusty hearing? That shall be believed;
What God's Son has told me, take for truth I do;
Truth himself speaks truly or there's nothing true.

The Holy Sacrament of the Altar is the Real Presence of Our Lord Himself. How blessed we are as Catholics to have this gift! I cannot imagine not being of the true faith in order to be in Communion with the Holy One of God under the disguise of Bread and Wine. Saint Francis de Sales said of the Blessed Sacrament, "When you have received Him, stir up your heart to do Him homage; speak to Him about your spiritual life, gazing upon Him in your soul where He is present for your happiness; welcome Him as warmly as possible, and behave outwardly in such a way that your actions may give proof to all of His Presence." It is always good to review the Church's customs and teachings that surround our life with the Blessed Sacrament. Firstly, we must note that all Catholics are bound, under pain of mortal sin, to participate in Holy Mass every Sunday. One should only receive Holy Communion in a state of grace or not being in mortal sin. Mortal sin is serious matter; sufficient reflection and full consent of the will. In other words, if we miss Mass, think about it and choose not to go, we have committed a serious sin. If one is sick or has an emergency, then we are not in sin. We should not receive Holy Communion until we have gone to confession. This is the teaching of the Church. Receiving the Lord in mortal sin is a sacrilege. Let us also remember to genuflect (if possible) whenever we enter the church before entering our pew or when we pass before the Blessed Sacrament. We should also make a sign of reverence before receiving the Lord. The bishops of the USA allow for a bow before receiving the Lord. We should answer "amen" rather than grunt and we should either receive in the beautiful, traditional way: on the tongue or if receiving in the hand, one hand under the other. Never walk away with the Lord in our hands but consume straightaway. Only those who cannot use both hands should receive in one hand. Holding a Rosary, Kleenex, car keys, etc. are not a good excuse. I can see if one hand has a cane, then it is understandable. When we go back to our pew, we should kneel, if possible, in prayerful thanksgiving for the glory we have just received. Finally, how beautiful it would be to have people not chatting in church. We could make our House of Charity goal if I had a dollar for every complaint I receive about the talking in church. People long to pray and meditate before the Sacrament. The open discussion is unbelievable and so loud. Some do not even try to whisper. Please, for your fellow brothers and sisters and even more so, out of respect for the Lord, let us speak in very hushed whispers in church when necessary and spend the time well talking to the Lord. Jesus would really love to hear from us, I am sure.

Dementia is a general term used to describe difficulties with thinking and memory. Alzheimer's disease is the most common type of dementia but dementia can be associated with several other conditions including Parkinson's. Dementia is not a part of normal aging.

If you are caring for a person with dementia, you know how very challenging it can be. Research is showing that music can help. Music can trigger emotions and memories and 'turn on' parts of the brain that other activities cannot. While it doesn't fix dementia, music that is familiar or has meaning to a person with dementia can boost their mood and functional ability—even if it is for just a little while. Sounds kind of obvious: music can do this for us whether we have dementia or not! So, if you are a caregiver, try putting some music in the day. It could be a joy shared that brightens the day.



The leading causes of death and disability in the U.S. are heart disease, cancer, chronic lung disease, stroke, diabetes and kidney disease. Lifestyle

factors that increase risk for these conditions include smoking/tobacco use, eating foods high in fat and calories, inadequate physical activity, and excessive alcohol intake. Support the men in your life to live long and healthy lives. Help them build good habits when they are still boys. And, gently nudge them (do not nag!) to keep a healthy balance of activity and fun! Make prevention a priority. Most importantly, be a role model.

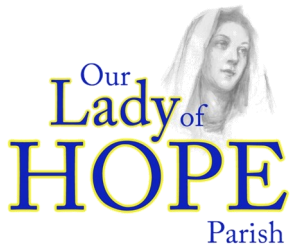

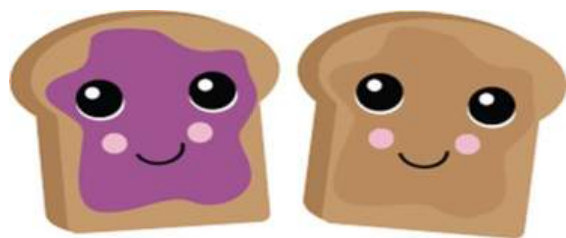

Saint's Corner: St Barbara: St Barbara was a virgin and a martyr. She lived in the 3rd/4th centuries where according to sources she was held captive by her father. He was the King of Nicomedia and he locked her away so that no man could have her. She lived inside her living quarters where she dedicated her life to becoming a Christian. When the King learned of her devotion and her desire to be a Christian, he denounced her to the prefect, who then condemned her to death. She was beheaded with her own father's sword and he in fact perished, incinerated by a bolt of lightning. Barbara has been worshipped since the 7th century. She is depicted as a young girl with a palm branch or peacock feather. Her attribute is the tower; she is involved against lightning. Barbara is the protector of architects, gunners, weapon makers, miners, masons, fireman, bell founders and those at risk of sudden death. The name Barbara is from the Greek meaning "foreigner"
