A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

Dear Friends in Christ,

We take this opportunity as a nation to wish all of our fathers a Happy Father's Day! How important fatherhood is to our society. The breakdown of fatherhood in family life is causing instability in society that is leading to confusion and moral decay. A blurring between the sexes is not leading to freedom, but confusion. I grew up in a traditional family where my parents' roles were very clear. Believe me, "Wait until your father gets home" was not an idle threat! Recently on the thirtieth anniversary of my ordination to the Priesthood, it hit me how much I miss my father. He is dead for only five months. I missed him on my anniversary as he was always the first one to call me to offer me good wishes. He would call early in the morning, and he would ask me, "Did you get my card?!" Boy, did I miss that call. Pope St. John Paul II wrote about how his father inspired his priestly vocation: "Day after day I was able to observe the austere way in which he lived. By profession he was a soldier, and, after my mother's death, his life became one of constant prayer. Sometimes I would wake up during the night and find my father on his knees, just as I would always see him kneeling in the parish church. We never spoke about a vocation to the priesthood, but his example was in a way my first seminary, a kind of domestic seminary." This is so beautiful. I am so blessed to be a spiritual Father and thus, I examine my conscience every day, assessing how I was a father to the faithful this day. To all you fathers, Happy Father's Day! There is a saying from an unknown author, "Dad, I know you've loved me as long as I've lived; but I've loved you my whole life."

Dementia is a general term used to describe difficulties with thinking and memory. Alzheimer's disease is the most common type of dementia but dementia can be associated with several other conditions including Parkinson's. Dementia is not a part of normal aging.

If you are caring for a person with dementia, you know how very challenging it can be. Research is showing that music can help. Music can trigger emotions and memories and 'turn on' parts of the brain that other activities cannot. While it doesn't fix dementia, music that is familiar or has meaning to a person with dementia can boost their mood and functional ability—even if it is for just a little while. Sounds kind of obvious: music can do this for us whether we have dementia or not! So, if you are a caregiver, try putting some music in the day. It could be a joy shared that brightens the day.



The leading causes of death and disability in the U.S. are heart disease, cancer, chronic lung disease, stroke, diabetes and kidney disease. Lifestyle

factors that increase risk for these conditions include smoking/tobacco use, eating foods high in fat and calories, inadequate physical activity, and excessive alcohol intake. Support the men in your life to live long and healthy lives. Help them build good habits when they are still boys. And, gently nudge them (do not nag!) to keep a healthy balance of activity and fun! Make prevention a priority. Most importantly, be a role model.

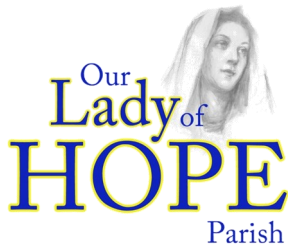

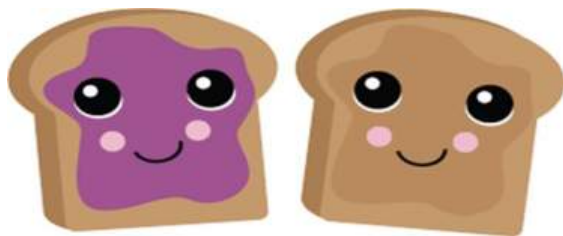

Saint's Corner: Saint Norbert: Saint Norbert was a lot like Saint Paul. He was first an enemy of Jesus and then turned into a strong, loyal Christian. Norbert was born in Germany and was a cousin to the emperor. He has nearly everything he ever wanted in life; money, popularity, and success. His carefree life, however, did not make him happy. One day as he was horseback riding through the woods, a heavy storm broke out unexpectedly. A sudden bolt of lightning frightened his horse. As the horse reared up, Norbert fell to the ground. When he regained consciousness, he considered the accident a warning from God. He wondered, "Lord, what do you want me to do?" Norbert seemed to hear a voice within him say, "Give up the foolish, empty life you are leading. Begin to do good to those around you." Norbert took these words seriously. He sold all his property and prepared to be ordained a priest. As a priest, Norbert preached to everyone about the danger of living the way he lived a few years before. So many young men who heard his message wanted to live the way Norbert did. This prompted him to begin several monasteries. He tried to build these monasteries in out-of-the-way places where people often didn't hear the Word of God. Near each monastery, Norbert usually opened a hospice. Here sick people, travelers, and pilgrims could find rest and help. The rule Norbert wrote for his priests to follow begins, "Be of one mind and heart in God." His order is called Premonstratensian, from Premontre, France, where Norbert established it. Norbert had great devotion to the Eucharist and encouraged respect and reverence for it. When Norbert died, he was an archbishop. He worked very hard to stop heresies and to encourage loyalty to the pope. He has preached with great success to the rich and the poor, to the wise and uneducated, an to believers and non believers. Saint Norbert is the patron saint of priests and peace. His feast day is June 6.
