A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

Our summer Religious Education Sessions are kicking off this week. Son seekers (note the spelling) are young people who come to the parish to learn about the Son. Some people really enjoy having their classes in the summer as they are more relaxed. Our prayer is that the children will realize that even at their young age, they are looking for someone to inspire them and to guide them. I can still remember some of the first stories that were read to me which put in me a love for reading. The story of a boy who had a weathervane collection was one of the first stories read to me and I still remember the story. One of the first books I read was given to me as a young reader was *Misty of Chincoteague*. I was blessed to visit the wild horses of Assateague a few years ago, bringing me back to my childhood. All this is passing compared to the Bible and those who teach us about Christ. Too often, the Lord Jesus is not being taught at home and therefore, catechism classes are even more essential. A recent survey showed that the average Catholic has the religious knowledge of a second grader. While we will never be able to fathom the mystery of God in totality; how we know Him, what we know about Him and how we live according to His teachings are necessary for us to reach the destiny that God wants for us...eternal life with Him. The sin of presumption is very prevalent today as so many people believe we are all going to heaven no matter what. Foolishly, hell is thought only to be for the likes of Judas or Adolf Hitler. The sin of presumption is a denial of our free will. What we choose and even more importantly, Who we choose affects eternal life. Our young Son Seekers remind us to continue to seek the Son of God in our own lives. We must never miss Mass unless we are ill and if we do so we should confess ourselves to a priest before receiving Holy Communion. If we are living with someone outside of a Catholic marriage or are sexually intimate outside of marriage, we must refrain from Holy Communion if not confessed. We must love to read the Word of God, pray the Holy Rosary, pray upon rising and pray as we close our eyes. "Sr. Lucia of Fatima told Cardinal Carlo Caffarra that a 'decisive battle between the kingdom of Christ and Satan will be over marriage and the family.'" God is all love and He is our final judge. Nothing unholy can go before God and therefore, Purgatory is mercy, no matter the pain it might cause. Isaiah 55:6-7 tells us, "Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon." We must look everywhere for the Lord and then, when we have found Him, we change our ways to be like Him. As the motto in the show *The Mandalorian* says, "It is the way."

Dementia is a general term used to describe difficulties with thinking and memory. Alzheimer's disease is the most common type of dementia but dementia can be associated with several other conditions including Parkinson's. Dementia is not a part of normal aging.

If you are caring for a person with dementia, you know how very challenging it can be. Research is showing that music can help. Music can trigger emotions and memories and 'turn on' parts of the brain that other activities cannot. While it doesn't fix dementia, music that is familiar or has meaning to a person with dementia can boost their mood and functional ability—even if it is for just a little while. Sounds kind of obvious: music can do this for us whether we have dementia or not! So, if you are a caregiver, try putting some music in the day. It could be a joy shared that brightens the day.



The leading causes of death and disability in the U.S. are heart disease, cancer, chronic lung disease, stroke, diabetes and kidney disease. Lifestyle

factors that increase risk for these conditions include smoking/tobacco use, eating foods high in fat and calories, inadequate physical activity, and excessive alcohol intake. Support the men in your life to live long and healthy lives. Help them build good habits when they are still boys. And, gently nudge them (do not nag!) to keep a healthy balance of activity and fun! Make prevention a priority. Most importantly, be a role model.

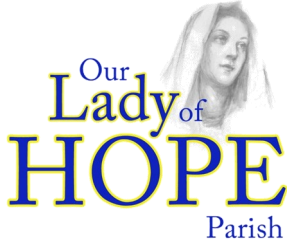

Saint's Corner: Saint Martha: One of the most precious things in life is to have a home where you can go at any time and find people who accept, love and understand you. Jesus found such a home in Bethany, at the house of a woman named Martha. She welcomed him and served him, and they developed a special bond of friendship. Martha lived with her sister, Mary. Like many other pairs of sisters, these two women were different in personality. Martha was energetic and outspoken, while Mary was quiet and reflective. Jesus loved both of them and appreciated the gifts that each one had. The Gospel of Luke records that once, when Jesus was visiting, Martha prepared a meal while Mary sat listening to the visitor. Martha complained that Jesus should tell Mary to help her. Jesus said that because Martha was worrying so much about the work, she did not have time to enjoy being with him and listening to his words. Another time recorded in John's Gospel, the sisters sent a message to Jesus that their brother, Lazarus, was ill. They knew Jesus would come and cure him; they trusted in his loving care for them. When Jesus finally came, Lazarus had already been dead four days. As soon as she heard Jesus was nearby, Martha, a woman of actions, went out to meet him, while Mary stayed in the house. In her grief, Martha told Jesus honestly what she had expected from him. Jesus asked her to believe that he was the resurrection and that he had power to give eternal life to all who believed in him. Without really understanding, Martha trusted Jesus totally and said, "I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who was to come into the world." That day Jesus raised her brother Lazarus from the dead, showing he has power over life and death and power to give eternal life. The home Jesus found in Bethany was not only in the house but in the faithful heart of a woman names Martha.
