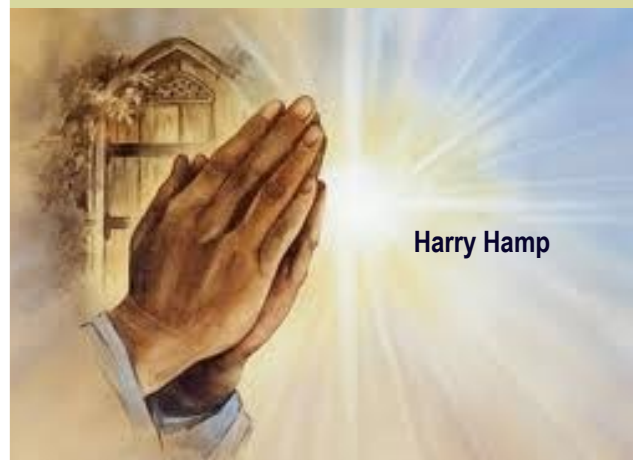

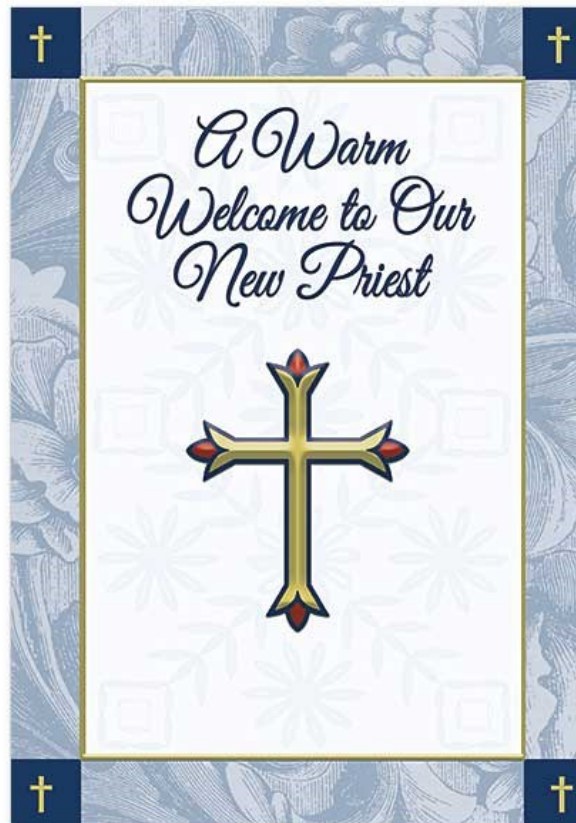
A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack

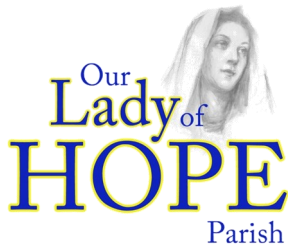
