A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack



Dear Friends in Christ,

This past week, we celebrated July 4th or Independence Day for our nation. I believe it was a day for all Americans to give thanks to the Lord for the blessings that He has bestowed upon our land. There is a great deal of criticism about the United States of America and yet, it is the greatest nation on earth. The division that our nation is suffering is so sad. But there is always hope...always. The Church calls us to see the dignity in every human being: from the baby newly conceived until the person dying to this life. Life is a gift that we must defend on every level. We are a good people. Our country is still a beacon of hope for many as we see waves of people wanting to come to this great land. If things are so terrible, why would so many want to come here? It is the same for New Jersey. How often we are the butt of jokes and yet, we are the most densely populated state in the country. Not perfect, but something is keeping people here. Our faith is paramount to the roots of this nation, and I do see that as the faith in Christ wanes, so does our country suffering great turmoil. 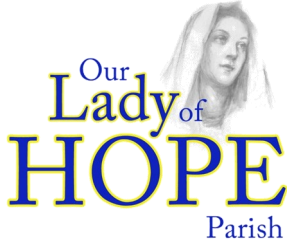
