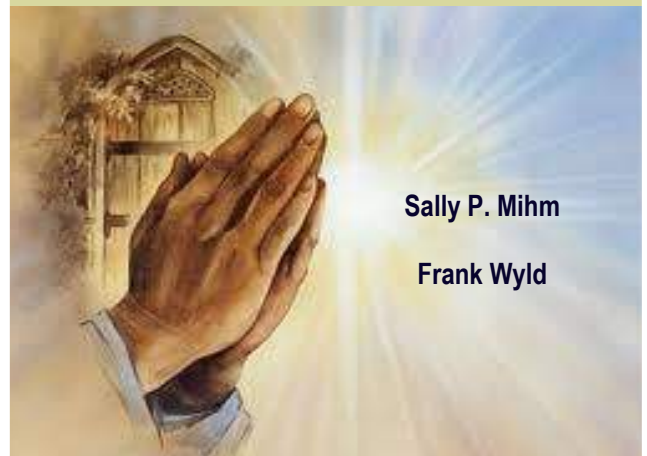

## *A Message from our Pastor, Rev. Joseph T. Szolack*



Dear Friends in Christ,

Prayerfully, your summer is unfolding in a serene and blessed way. Firstly, I want to point out that should you ever receive any type of request for money through money cards or transfer of money, it will not be coming from me and should be disregarded. I would only write to you in some way for money if it is a Church program such as Catholic Strong. You will have heard of this through announcements. Outside of this, I would always ask for financial help in person. Be assured, I will never ask for money for personal purposes. On another note, do not forget to see the movie, *Sound of Freedom*. We need to have our eyes opened to realize that so many of our little ones are in danger. This summer we have our religious education program under way which goes under the name of Son Seekers. It is so important that we pray for our young souls in our parish and that we give a good example. It is odd that one would be a Son Seeker, no matter one's age and not seek the Lord in Sacred Scripture, Church doctrine and to find Jesus in Holy Mass and the Sacraments. We too often hear that we need to be a "listening Church." I am all for this, *if*, we are listening to the Lord Jesus through the Holy Spirit. We are too often encouraged to sit around and talk about doing good with only one person being left out: Jesus! Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth and the life." (John 14:6). We need to strive for holiness in imitation of Jesus. The Church's mission is to make disciples of all peoples for Jesus Christ. Our primary role is not the environment, the economy, etc. These are important issues for many, but the primary role of the Church is to save souls in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Allow the young members of our parish remind us to all be Son Seekers, not using Jesus as a reflection of a false God of our own creation, but rather the Savior of the world who tells us, "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9). Jesus is the only way to salvation, and it is time that we spent more time listening to Him. Our Lady said it all, "Do whatever He tells you." (John 2:5).

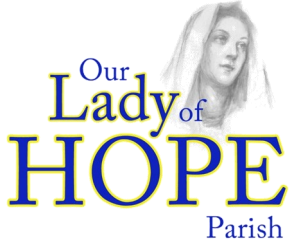
