Son Seekers

The second week of July we hosted 85 children in our Son Seekers program. Our day began with the children attending Mass. The children spent time learning about Jesus and all his teachings. Many of the children went to the Grotto, toured the Church, spoke with a sacristan and walked the grounds gaining lessons on what it means to be a Catholic.

At the end of this long week, the children committed themselves to a service project. They made 528 peanut butter and jelly sandwiches which were taken to the Cathedral Kitchen in Camden. In addition to the sandwiches, the children packaged 210 utensil bags which included fork, spoon, salt/pepper and a napkin. A shout out to Trudy Cranston and Mary Jo Dwyer who took these items to Camden. They spent the week teaching and I know they were exhausted. We look forward to the next session in August.
