Dear Friends in Christ,

Recently I saw on YouTube scenes from the streets of Milan, Italy showing how men and women in that city dress. It was interesting to see people of all ages both young and old extremely well-dressed walking along the shops. It led me to wonder what they were saying by what they wear. Was it that they are merely self-possessed? Are they vain? What it did say to me was that it mattered to the Italians who have a sense of fashion, food, art and living life. Without being self-absorbed, I hold that manners and the how we comport ourselves says a great deal about who we are and how we want to present to others. Good manners are about the other person. We want the other to feel comfortable, so acting civilized allows another person to enjoy our company. Good manners should certainly be extended to Our Lord. "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength." (Mark 12:30). Thus, how we make the Sign of the Cross, how we genuflect in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament (not the bow, unless we are unable to genuflect) speaks of devotion to the Presence of Jesus. I always rejoice when our altar servers and lectors genuflect instead of bowing upon entering the sanctuary. What the priest and deacons wear is all symbolic and vestments are not simply a color, but when they are beautiful and devotional, they too preach a message. How we come dressed for Mass says a lot. My nephew was recently visiting from the south and he noted the big difference in the way people dress for Mass here verses Mass in South Carolina. Jesus must be the center of all things and everything we say and do can be a prayer. Personally, I would never want to say to the Lord that I dress better for a job interview than I do for entering into His holy presence. Again, we all do not have the high taste of the Milanese, but a dirty t-shirt with a profane message on it is not what I would want to say about who I am. I understand those who say, well at least we are at Mass and that the Lord does not care what we wear or whether we openly speak out loud when people in our midst are trying to pray. Each of us must investigate our hearts and see if we are praying with our whole being. An interesting quote from Laurence Sterne, "Respect for ourselves guides our morals; respect for others guides our manners."

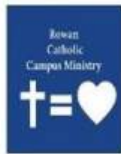

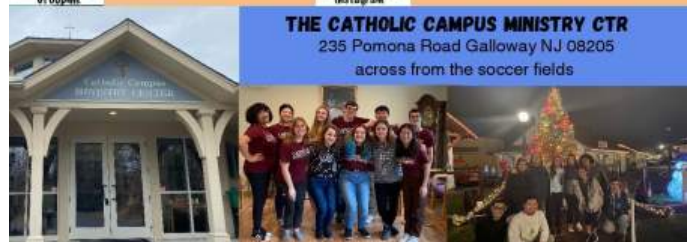

August is National Breast-Feeding Month

Moms who breast feed their babies also get health benefits including a lower risk of breast cancer. Human milk costs nothing compared to formula, is clean and always at the right temperature. While there are many benefits of providing babies human milk, workplace challenges are a common reason women stop or never try breast feeding. If you have doubts or feel skeptical, it's understandable, but we urge you to take an honest look at the science behind vaccination as well as public health records from countries around the world. Using both faith and reason, vaccination might be seen as an act of love.
