Dear Friends in Christ,

While Autumn is my favorite season, there is always a bit of melancholy about the new year starting up again. As in life, our parish has activities that will bring it even more to life. Of course, we continued Holy Mass and the Sacraments, and we offered Funeral Masses for those whom the Lord called home. Our luau was a great parish, summer activity and we are in the planning stages for upcoming events. Please don't forget to pray to see if you are called to participate this fall and winter in Christ Life. We continue as a Church to revive in our hearts the gift of the Most Blessed Sacrament. We are blessed to have our chapel open every day from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Reverently, at the Shrine of Czestochowa in Doylestown, the Tabernacle was moved from the side altar to the center at its proper place of honor. The Pauline Father being interviewed said that this was a gift in honor of the year of the Eucharist. What is our gift to the Lord in His Real Presence? Perhaps one can go to Mass during the week in addition to the Sunday obligation. A Holy Hour or at least some time in the Lord's Real Presence is a wonderful way to love Him. Maybe our deportment in the Lord's Presence can be intensified. Unless we are infirmed, a true genuflection carried out with intention is a way to improve our devotion and belief. Do we make a Sign of the Cross when we pass a Catholic Church, greeting our Lord in His house? How do we receive Holy Communion? If we receive the traditional way, on the tongue, do we do so with reverence? This is not usually an issue when receiving this way, but when it comes to receiving Holy Communion in the hand, sometimes it is frightening to see the carelessness. Spend some time in prayer meditating on how you receive the King of Kings. Do we follow the fast of one hour before the receiving of Holy Communion and do we go to confession so that we do not receive Him sacrilegiously? I knew a family who when saying grace before dinner would pray the Divine Praises. It was so beautiful. Let us do something in honor of the Lord's Real Presence, a Gift beyond any gift. "I adore You, Lord and Creator, hidden in the Most Blessed Sacrament. I adore You for all the works of Your hands, that reveal to me so much wisdom, goodness and mercy, O Lord. You have spread so much beauty over the earth and it tells me about Your beauty, even though these beautiful things are but a faint reflection of You, incomprehensible Beauty. And although You have hidden Yourself and concealed your beauty, my eye, enlightened by faith, reaches You and my souls recognizes its Creator, its Highest Good, and my heart is completely immersed in prayer of adoration." (*From the writings of Saint Faustina*).

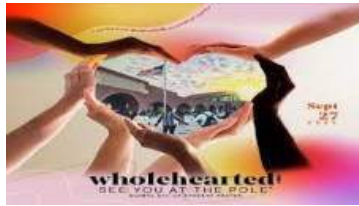

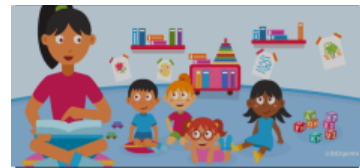

COLLEGE BOUND

6 Bible Verses for College Students with reflections

1. Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

God wants me to succeed. Whenever I'm feeling stressed about my classes, or my major, or what I'm going to do with my life, this verse calms me. I know through faith in God, my life will not go wrong. Bad things may happen, and everything may not go as I plan, but in the end, I can survive it all as long as I trust in God and his plan.

2. Romans 12:12 Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.

Sometimes, I feel lost. In those times, I usually realize that I haven't prayed recently. I don't always remember to be constant in prayer but through periods when I do, I realize how much better my life is.

3. Romans 8:28: And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

Not only did they help with Son Seekers but they served as Altar Servers for the week and recruited potential servers all week. The girls also spoke to all the children about being Altar Servers and they spoke about different saints. As always, our staff, Mary Jo Dwyer, Trudy Cranston and myself were present all four weeks. It was exhausting but so worth the while. We were fortunate enough to have two Knights of Columbus, Mike Mount and Chris Chiaro, volunteer to drive to the Cathedral Kitchen in Camden, NJ to deliver the peanut butter and jelly sandwiches.

Our sessions would not have been successful without the hard work of our Maintenance Department Norberto Cruz and Lou Maiese. Thank you for all the extras you both did for our children. Your commitment to our church, especially our department, will not be forgotten.

A huge appreciation to all the people who donated peanut butter, jelly, bread, sandwich bags and other items to our program. You helped make our service project extremely successful..
