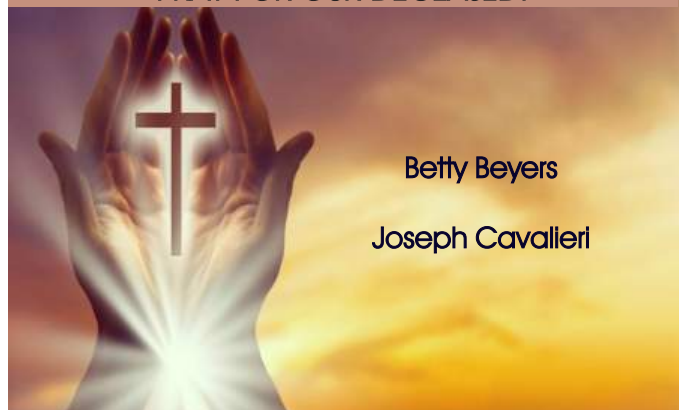



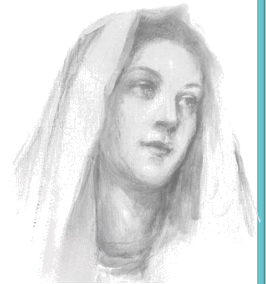

Saint Charles Borromeo:

Charles Borromeo was a highly gifted and serious young man. By the time he was twenty-one he has doctorates in civil and canon law. He was called to Rome, by his uncles, Pope Pius IV, and made a cardinal and administrator of Milan, Italy. As secretary of state at the Vatican, Charles was in charge of all the papal states. He also worked closely with the pope at the Council of Trent, when many topics led to heated arguments. Charles, working behind the scenes, helped keep many people together. Charles decided to be a priest instead. Shortly after he was ordained he was made the bishop of Milan. Although the pope wanted Charles to stay in Rome, Charles wanted to be with his people in Milan. There his talents and holiness became clear, for, more than anyone else at the time, he tried to make the decrees and changes of the council alive in his diocese. He traveled through his diocese constantly. He setup orphanages, hospitals, homes for neglected women, seminaries and colleges. He tried to reform the lives of priests and religious. He stated a group of priests called the Oblates of St. Ambrose to help him. Once Charles tried to reform a religious order that became so angry that they hired a hitman to kill him. An attempt was made on his life as he prayed, but he was not killed. In 1567 when a plague and famine broke out, he stayed with the ill and dying even when city officials fled. He cared for them, sleeping and eating little. He sold all he had to he could feed the 60, 000-70,000 in need. When he was 46 years old, Charles died, worn out from caring for others and bearing the burdens of his position. Charles never asked of his priests and other religious more than he was willing to do. His feast day is November 4 and he is the patron saint of catechists, catechumens and seminaries.
