Dear Friends in Christ,

As we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving as a nation, I want to assure the faithful of Our Lady of Hope that I consider serving you a great blessing. As Scripture offers, “I never stop giving thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, would give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him” (Ephesians 1:16-23). The traditional antidote to selfishness which seems so prevalent in our society is thanksgiving. When we examine our conscience at night, we should spend more time thanking the Lord than going over sins and asking forgiveness. Certainly, we need to be aware of our sins and repent, but Saint Ignatius of Loyola reminds us that the blessing, goodness, and generosity of God are so much larger than even our foolish sins. I would think it a time to give thanks for the blessings upon our nation and to put aside this Thursday the anger and negativity that seems to be growing. There is so much strife in the world that despite the challenges in our country, we remain blessed by the favor of Almighty God. 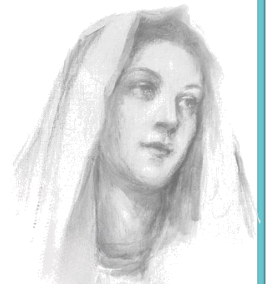

We know very little about Cecilia, although stories and legends abound. She lived in the second century during the time of great persecutions. Stories tell us that as a young girl she wanted to give her life to God. Her parents forced her to marry a nobleman named Valerian. In time, she converted him and his brother Tiburtius to the faith. All three of them died as martyrs. A legend says that Cecilia was struck three times in the neck with a sword and lived three days. She asked the Pope to make her home a church. Her remains were taken to Rome, where a Basilica was built in her honor. Cecilia is often pictured with a musical instrument; a small organ, a harp or a viola. An account of her wedding says that while the musicians played, Cecilia sang to the Lord in her heart. In the later Middle Ages, she was pictured playing the organ and singing aloud. Cecilia's picture reminds us that the Church has always recognized the value of music and song. Her feast day is November 22 and she is the patron saint of musicians, music and poets.
