Dear Friends in Christ,

We know that this time of year, colds and flu spread like wildfire amongst the people. Your three priests, called to serve you, have not been immune. The three of us have suffered from the recent flu that involves cough and exhaustion. It is always terrible to be sick, especially during the holidays, but it is passing fortunately. More concerning is the spiritual sickness that does not go away as easily, and which is much more dangerous since this type of sickness involves our eternal life with God. Recently, I saw a YouTube piece where a man asked people on the street if they believe in Jesus. The answers were a bit disconcerting. Some said, "I don't discuss religion", "Sometimes...", and a number said, "No!" The indifference to the Lord is frightening to me. This year, we did not have a leap in people coming to Mass for Christmas. Many had used Covid as an excuse, even after the bishops allowed us to return. We just do not care about Him and we think that it does not matter what we believe, how we live and whether we utter a few crumbs of prayers to the Almighty King. The Lord once told Mother Teresa, "They can't love me because they don't know me." We need to know our faith! We need to read the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. We need to read solid Catholic teachings. People have come to me concerned about even utterings of the hierarchy. Know the faith! Too often, we see the Pope and those in the hierarchy as oracles, this is not true. While the role of the Holy Father is to protect the faith, we must realize that all of us allow our own opinions at times to come forward. Personally, I am not that interested in opinions, but rather, I want to delve deeper into Sacred Scripture and the true Magisterium of the Church. For the good of one's soul, be faithful to Holy Mass, the Sacraments and the moral teachings of the Church. January 26, 1947, Archbishop Fulton Sheen said, "Why is it that so few realize the seriousness of our present crisis?" he asked 72 years ago. Then gave the answer: "Partly because men do not want to believe their own times are wicked, partly because it involves too much self-accusation, and principally because they have no standards outside of themselves by which to measure their times... Only those who live by faith really know what is happening in the world. The great masses without faith are unconscious of the destructive processes going on." It reminds me of a line from Jesus Christ Superstar, "If you knew all that I knew my poor Jerusalem, you'd see the truth, but you close your eyes." Please my friends, let us keep our eyes and ears open. The wolves have been set loose amongst the sheep as Jesus predicted. He will protect us if we stay close to the Good Shepherd. Only He can keep us from the harm of this world.

Blessed Andre Bessette:

The most unlikely people can become a saint. Andre Bessette was sickly all his life. He failed at every job he tried. He could barely read and write. Yet he became famous and well beloved for his holiness. Andre, the eighth of twelve children, was born in Montreal, Canada and was later baptized Alfred. His parents, who were French /Canadian, died early. Andrea was adopted at the age of twelve and became a farmhand. Later he tried being a shoemaker, baker, and a blacksmith but was unsuccessful at all of it. Andre then joined the Congregation of the Holy Cross. At the end of a year, he was told he had to leave because of his bad health. Luckily, a wise bishop convinced the community to allow Andre to remain. Brother Andre became a beloved doorkeeper at the College of Notre Dame for forty years. In his room, near the door, Andre kept a statue of Saint Joseph on the windowsill. Andre spent many hours praying during the night. Soon it was discovered Andre had healing power. He would visit the sick, pray with them, rub them with oil and they would be cured. Before long, throngs of people were coming to him for healing and spiritual direction. Andre would say, "It is Saint Joseph who cures. I am just his little dog". Andre ministered to the people 8-10 hours a day. In the meantime, four secretaries were kept busy handling the 80,000 letters Andre received each year. The Holy Cross Community had tried in vain to buy a piece of land nearby. Then Andre buried a medal of Saint Joseph and suddenly, the owners agreed to sell the land. Andre raised money for the chapel and then a church on the property. It took 50 years to complete the St. Josephs Oratory, which is probably the worlds main shrine to Saint Joseph. Andre, the weak failure, let God to use him to accomplish great things.
