Dear Friends in Christ,

We have an incredibly special time of the year coming up this week, our annual Forty Hours Celebration. Holy Mother Church is requesting that we renew and expand our love for the Lord's Real Presence in our midst. Our parish is extremely centered on prayer in the presence of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Our Forty Hours of love for the Lord will begin after the 9:00 AM Mass on Tuesday, January 16th with perpetual prayer before the Holy Sacrament day and night until the closing, which will take place on Thursday, January 18th. The only interruption of prayer before the Sacrament will be for the celebration of the Masses. On Tuesday, January 16th, Wednesday, January 17th and Thursday, January 18th we will celebrate Holy Mass each night at 7:00 PM in our Saint Agnes Church. On Wednesday, we will have confessions after the 7:00 PM Mass as adoration continues. Our closing of Forty Hours on Thursday will involve a procession with the Blessed Sacrament in the Church. I encourage all to attend these times of prayer. It is appropriate for all who serve in any way at Mass, it is especially right for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Altar Servers to walk in procession with the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. Please plan on spending as much time as possible each of the days during Forty Hours. The Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration write, "The most powerful thing we can do on this earth with our time is to spend it in Eucharistic adoration. Nothing can do more to change the world, to bring about peace, to convert hearts, to make reparation for the many evils committed. Spending time in prayer may seem, on the outside, to be a passive thing; however, it is anything but! Our world is in desperate need of hope, of renewal, of a 'turning back' to the things of God. By visiting Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, we take up the best weapon for the battles of our age and contribute to the healing of our culture. Cultivating a Eucharistic life of adoration also bears tremendous fruit in our own hearts and lives. We cannot spend time in the rays of His Eucharistic Presence without receiving His grace, His love, His mercy, His peace. As we gaze upon Him Face to fac, we are transformed little by little into a closer reflection of His divine image." I look forward to praying with you in the Presence of the Lord. Remember that the Sacrament can never be left alone, so we need two people at every hour. Augustine Maria of the Blessed Sacrament once said, "Yes, I am happy, perfectly happy; and do you wish to know where I find true happiness? At the feet of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. "Give yourself a gift and spend time with the greatest of all Gifts!

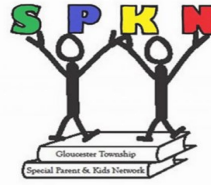

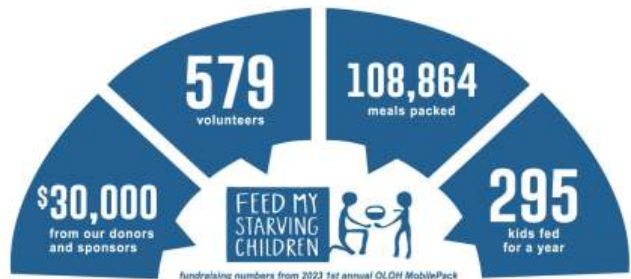

Saint Hilary:

When Hilary was born in Poitiers, France, to pagan parents, no one would have guessed he would one day be exiled for defending Christian beliefs. After a thorough education, Hilary married. He and his wife had a daughter, Afra. All who knew Hilary said he was a friendly, charitable, and gentle man. Hilary's studies led him to read Scripture. He became convinced that there was only one God whose Son became man and then died and rose to save all people. This belief led him to be baptized a Christian along with his wife and Afra. The people of Poitiers were impressed with Hilary and chose him to be their bishop. Hilary spoke out against Arianism. He warned people of this heresy that denied that Christ was God. When Emperor Constantius II wanted Hilary to sign a paper condemning Saint Athanasius, the great defender of faith, he refused. Furious, the emperor exiled Hilary to Phrygia. In exile for three years, he did even greater good through his preaching, writing and suffering. He even asked to debate the Arian bishops. The followers of Arianism begged the emperor to send Hilary home. The emperor recalled Hilary home. Hilary's writings show that he could be fierce in defending the faith, but in dealing with the bishops who had given in to the Arian heresy, he was very charitable. He showed them their errors and helped them regain and defend their faith. Although the emperor called Hilary, "disturber of the peace", Saints Jerome and Augustine praised him as "teacher of the church". Saint Hilary was also one of the first Latin hymn writers. He saw how Saint Ambrose used them against Arianism. He is the protector against snakes and the patron saint of lawyers.
