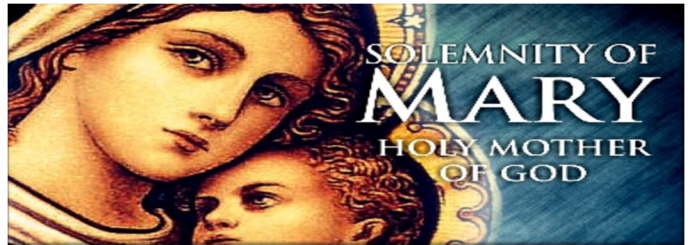

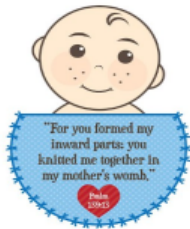

Sanit Basil the Great & St. Gregory Nazianzen:

Have you ever heard of a family whose members all became canonized saints? It happened in Saint Basil's family. His grandmother, father, mother, two brothers, and a sister became saints. Of all of them, Basil is the one known best. Basil enjoyed life at the university. There he met Gregory Nazianzen, a quiet, scholarly man. The two became friends. Basil traveled through the East, studying monastic life. As a result, he formed his own monastic group and invited Gregory to join him. From their discussions, Basil wrote a rule of life for the monks that many Eastern monks still follow. He stressed a community life devoted to liturgical prayer, Scripture study, and manual work. He allowed monks and nuns to operate hospitals, guesthouses, and to do other good works outside the community when necessary. The two good friends lived the monastic life for only about 5 years. Then Gregory returned home to care for his father, who was a bishop. (In those days married priests were not unusual. Priests can still be married today in Eastern Rites). Gregory was ordained and watched over his father's diocese. In 374 Basil was made Bishop of Caesarea. The Church called on him to fight in the Arian heresy promoted by the emperor. This heresy claimed that Jesus was not God. Basil preached to crowds and wrote against the Arian heresy and about the Trinity and the Incarnation. When famine struck, Basil gave money to the poor, organized a soup kitchen and served people himself. After the emperor died, the heresy weakened. The nearby priests begged Gregory to restore faith there. Gradually he brought the people back to the faith. Basil and Gregory worked for peace and unity in the church. Their feast day is January 02 and they are the patron saints of hospital administrators, reformers, monks, education, poets, harvests, and liturgists.
