Dear Friends in Christ,

Once again, we are preparing to kick off another year of the House of Charity/The Bishop's Annual Appeal (Now known as South Jersey Catholic Ministries Appeal). Last year we achieved our goal, and I am so grateful to all who made this possible. In reality though, it is not the goal that matters as much as what your generosity accomplishes in the lives of so many. The theme this year is "Through Him and for Him." I love that the theme this year is so incarnational. It recalls the words of the Lord, "Whatever you do to the least of my brothers, you do unto me." This is an opportunity to give directly to Jesus through the poor. The South Jersey Catholic Ministries Appeal continues to aid our future priests as they prepare in the seminary for ordained ministry. Our deacons are supported in their formation, and we see Him in the sick, the elderly, the youth, and young adults and in the poor. The House of Charity is your household. We are called to be houses of charity. Asked to give of ourselves by serving others in whomever God's puts in our daily path, we help those in need with our monetary resources. There are many times when we ask you to give to your parish and to the diocese, but this collection is one in which we can all participate and allow others to encounter the living God. An encounter is a meeting, especially one that is unplanned. It amazes me that the more we are generous towards others, the more we receive so many blessings in return. This is one way that we ourselves can encounter the living God. I ask you to please give to the House of Charity this year and to do so with a smile (not always easy!). St. Paul tells us, "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:7). Our goal is very substantial; it is \$ 210, 200.00 (the same as last year). Once again, I am entrusting our campaign to Saint Kateri Tekakwitha, the Lily of the Mohawks. I am confident that with her prayers and your generosity, we can make our goal easily if we all do our part. St. Paul instructs us to smile when we give, let us encounter the living God in the smile of the person who is in desperate need and who is saved by our generosity. You will have the opportunity to see the film prepared by the diocese at upcoming Masses and on our parish website. As usual, I would never ask anything of you that I would not do. I plan on being generous to this important endeavor. In advance, thank you so much! Saint Kateri Tekakwitha, pray for us!

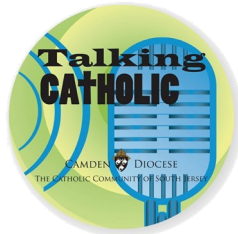

Saint Ansgar:

Saint Ansgar worked very hard, but he lived to see his work destroyed and his efforts proved apparently fruitless. Ansgar was born in France. He entered the Benedictine Order and became a powerful speaker and teacher. He was sent as a missionary to Denmark. For three years he worked and ministered to the people there, with little success. When Sweden asked for missionaries, Ansgar again set out, this time with another monk. On the way, the two men were captured by pirates and suffered many hardships before they finally reached Sweden. Less than two years later, Ansgar was recalled and made bishop of Hamburg. For thirteen years, Ansgar worked and prayed in Hamburg. He was known for his excellent preaching, his great love of the poor and the sick, and his humble, prayerful life. He gave his all to the people, leading his flock to Christ. Then another suffering came. In 845 Hamburg was invaded by the Northman and burned to the ground. Ansgar then saw the people return to paganism. Still he continued. Ansgar was appointed archbishop of Bremen and in 854 began new missionary work in Sweden and Denmark. He asked for only one miracle—that God would make him a good man. Deep in his heart, he carried the desire to give his life for his faith, to show his love through martyrdom. He died peacefully, however, at Bremen. After his death, Sweden once again returned to paganism. Looking at Ansgar's life, we see one defeat after another. Yet Ansgar was a winner in all the things that really mattered in life, in love and devotion, sacrifice and prayer, in giving of self to God and to others. May we remember the life of Ansgar, the Apostle of the North, and be winners in Christ. Ansgar was the patron saint of Frances, Denmark, Sweden, Germany and Iceland.
