A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today, February 11th, is the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, when the Church celebrates World Day of the Sick. Pope Saint John Paul II inaugurated this celebration where we remember to pray for the sick and to pray, in a special way, for all those who work in the health field. Certainly, all of us have various doctors and we are taken care of by wonderful nurses when we are in hospital or receiving treatments. The World Day of the Sick is connected to Our Lady of Lourdes because of the great healings that take place at that beautiful shrine, dedicated to Our Lady, where people take a quick dip in the healing waters. Our Lord especially wants to heal our soul and while He normally does not contradict human nature, the Lord will physically heal us when it gives glory to the Father or for His own purposes. Almighty God has given great gifts through our knowledge of the healing arts of medicine. Our parish has a Parish Nurses Group and if you are a nurse and are interested in participating with this group, please call your name into the office and we will contact you. I thank each of our nurses and assure them of my prayers on this day, whether active or retired. On another note, this Wednesday, February 14th is Ash Wednesday. It is one of the most special days of the year when so many people come out to the church to receive ashes on their foreheads to kick off the Lenten Season. Remember, it is not a one-day event, but the beginning of the most intense season of the year that will lead us into the Easter Season. Remember that all Roman Catholics must fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Fridays during Lent call one to abstain from meat. The regulation for fasting is ages 18 to 59 and abstaining from meat is for those 14 years of age and older. We will have our traditional Soup and Scripture: soup, bread, and water at 5:30 PM and a talk at 6:00 PM. This will take place in our hall. Please see the bulletin on page 6 for the Ash Wednesday schedule. By the grace of God, we may not all be physically sick, but we all suffer from spiritual illness and a good Lent is the great medicine for all that sickens our soul. While the Church does not regulate anything for us to “give up,” it is a venerable and valuable tradition. Personally, I like to take on something more spiritual (reading a new spiritual book, more frequent visits to the Blessed Sacrament, praying the Stations of the Cross in our Grotto, etc.). Then I give up alcohol, sweets, and other things. I tried to drink my coffee black; it just has not happened! It goes without saying that confession is something that is essential to spiritual growth. Please do not let these special days slip by. Enjoy Mardi Gras or Fat Tuesday, clearing all the sweets and junk out of our house to prepare for a grace filled Lent.

Saint Josephine Bakhita:

Saint Josephine Bakhita was born in 1869 in Darfur, now the Sudan. Her father was well respected and prosperous, and he was the brother of the village chief. She was surrounded by 3 sisters and 3 brothers who were all loving towards her. In 1877, when she was 7-8 years old, she was seized by Arab slave traders, who had taken her sister 2 years prior. She was forced to walk over 600 miles to El-Obeid. Along the way she was bought and sold twice. Bakhita was not her given name at birth, but one that was given to her by her slave owners. She had forgotten her given name after she was taken. During her time in slavery, she was beaten, tortured, and tattooed against her will. When she was sold to an Italian Council, who lived in Italy, Josephine was finally with an owner who wasn't mean to her. After 2 years with her current owner, the two of them escaped with a friend, Augusto Michieli. When they headed back towards Italy, they found Augusto's wife now owned Bakhita. She lived with them for three years before they took her back to the Sudan. They stayed for 9 months before heading back to Italy. While there, Bakhita, cared for and was nanny to the children the couple had. As Bakhita helped raise the children, the couple decided to leave Italy and head back to the Sudan after only 9 months. With her husband in the Sudan for business, Turnia Michieli decided she wanted to see her husband in the Sudan. Since the villa was already sold, Bakhita and one of the children would need a temporary place to live. The Canossian Sisters in Venice could temporarily take them in. They were well cared for by the sisters and they received instructions from the sisters as well. They encountered real teachings of Christianity which they had never had before. Grateful to her teachers, she recalled, "The holy mothers instructed me with heroic patience and introduced me to God who from childhood I had felt in my heart without knowing who He was." When Michieli returned to take her daughter and maid back, Bakhita refused to leave. For three days, Michieli tried to force the issue, finally appealing to the attorney general of the King of Italy, while the superior of the Institute for baptismal candidates the Bakhita attended contact the Patriarch of Venice about her protégée's problem. On November 29, 1889, an Italian court ruled that because the British has outlawed slavery in Sudan before Bakhita's birth and because Italian law had never recognized slavery as legal, Bakhita had never legally been a slave. For the first time in her life, Bakhita found herself in control of her own destiny, and she chose to remain with the Canossians. On January 9, 1890, Bakhita was baptized with the names, 'Josephine Margaret' and received communion from Archbishop Giuseppe Sarto, the Cardinal Patriarch of Venice, and later Pope Pius X. In December 1896, she took her vows and was assigned in northern Italy, where she spent the rest of her life. During her 42 years in northern Italy, she was employed as a cook, sacristan, door-keeper and was in frequent contact with the local community Her gentle and calming voice, and the ever-present smile was well known. Her last years were filled with pain and sickness, yet she remained cheerful. Bakhita died on February 8, 1947 with her last audible words being. "Our Lady, Our Lady!"
