Dear Friends in Christ,

Sometimes, about this time, we may begin to falter in our personal Lenten program. Perseverance is extremely important in the spiritual life. This virtue is also known traditionally as “constancy.” Father Tanqueray defines constancy as a *“struggling and suffering to the end, without yielding to weariness, discouragement, or indolence.”* If we have chosen challenging things to do in order to grow closer to God and to love our neighbor as ourselves, we may start cutting corners, often making excuses to figure ways to get around our commitments without feeling guilt. Moderns like to see results immediately and when not seeing the graces straightaway, we give up. This is part of the effects of original sin. Father Tanqueray says, *“that perseverance is a gift of God obtained by prayer.”* He also reminds us to return to our original commitment as soon as possible and he also says that we must “courageously” return to our tasks. The Lord gives us blessings and consolations to encourage us. An expectation of our “spiritual candy” though, is not helpful since when we do not get a consolation, we think that we are abandoned or unloved by God. It seems so unjust that I am doing this and that, and seemingly getting nothing for my efforts! Our efforts are teaching us so much: we are more disciplined, enlightened, we see that we do not really need what we think we need, we see the fruits of patience, chastity amongst other blessings.

The Lord knows exactly what we need and when we need it. We must trust Him and be assured that no prayer is ever wasted. We should examine ourselves under the three-fold, traditional Lenten program: prayer, fasting and alms giving. These three areas contain numerous opportunities to grow in these very special weeks.

So, if one has fallen off the spiritual wagon, let us pray for one another to get back on, pray for strength and respond to the graces given with trust and fortitude. Mass and confession are assured paths to holiness. Saint Francis de Sales reminds us, *“Have patience with all things, but chiefly have patience with yourself. Do not lose courage in considering your own imperfections but instantly set about remedying them – every day begin the task anew.”* Never give up!

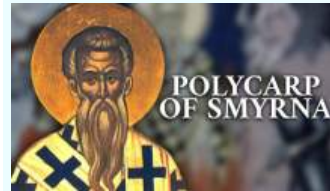

First Holy Communion:

Saint Polycarp was a disciple of Saint John the apostle. While still quite young, he became the bishop of Smyrna and was one of the most respected leaders in the first half of the second century. Saint Ignatius of Antioch and Saint Irenaeus spoke highly of him, and the people loved him very much. Polycarp was a Christian leader in a pagan world. He spoke clearly and simply, fearless in his love and defense of Christ, even though persecutions raged around him. He sought only to hand on the message he has been given by John, who has seen and heard and followed Jesus Christ. Even as Polycarp prepared for martyrdom, his joy and confident trust were evident to all. Polycarp was seized for being a Christian. He was threatened and pressured in many ways, yet he declared to his captors, *"For eighty-six years I have served Jesus Christ, and he has never abandoned me. How could I curse my blessed King and Savior?"* Persecution and death would not tear him away from Jesus now. Polycarp was led into the stadium in Smyrna. The crowd demanded he be left to the lions and he was instead sentenced to death by fire. An eyewitness account said the flames did not touch him. He was finally killed by a sword and his body burned. Christians buried his remains. The community of believers celebrated the anniversary of Polycarp's death with great joy, for in him they had seen an outstanding example of love and patience. He had held strong and had won the treasure of eternal life. Polycarp is remembered as an Apostolic Father, one who was a disciple of the apostles. We may not see Jesus in the flesh, but we see him with eyes of faith. Like Polycarp, we are called to hand on the tradition of giving Christian witness joyfully, no matter that the cost.
