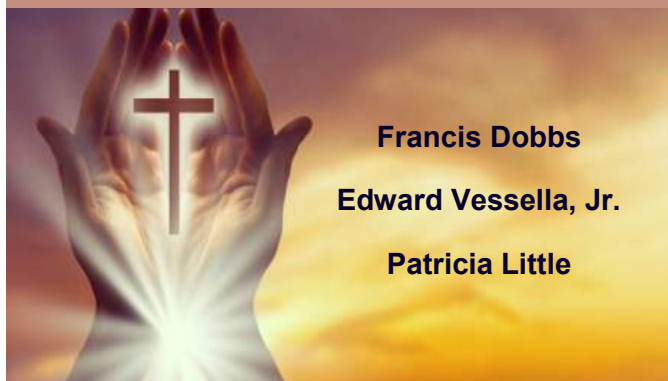

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Easter to everyone and Blessed Divine Mercy Sunday! Now is the time to savor the mystery of the Risen Lord Who made it possible to choose to follow Him and love Him. Through His mercy, we might go to heaven. Our parish had a beautiful Lent and numerous celebrations surrounding the mysteries of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Our Lord. We began, what was weeks ago, our Lent, with the reception of burnt palm on our foreheads. We were entreated to change our lives and to seek ways to be better disciples of the Lord Jesus. Every Friday, during Lent, we had an opportunity for meditation, especially in our Soup and Scripture. Thank you to all the various ministries who provided different choices of meatless soups for the five Fridays that we meditated on the Joys and Sorrows of Saint Joseph. I was so happy to see great attendance in the participation each week in praying the Stations of the Cross in the church. We had a beautiful meditative celebration with the Irish tenor, Mark Forrest, powered by Our Lord's Real Presence being carried amongst the faithful. Our Palm Sunday saw well attended Masses and we were once again treated to a very enjoyable breakfast hosted by the Knights of Columbus. Good job men, Vivat Jesus! The Holy Triduum or three days before Easter was so prayerful and I am so grateful to all who participated and who helped during these days to enhance our celebrations so powerfully. Father Antony, Father Polansky and I heard hours of confessions. This sacrament is essential to anyone who is serious about their spiritual life and to anyone who desires to convert continuously to the Lord Jesus. Thank you so much Mike Alibrando for all the planning and carrying out of the numerous details that go into the Triduum and to all the sacristans who worked so hard to prepare the altar at the Masses. Our choir, under the direction of John Wernega, was fantastic and I know that they worked hard to prepare for these blessed celebrations. Thank you to Ted Kiefer and the cantors who led us in prayer at numerous times, including Lauds celebrated in the morning of each of the days of the Holy Triduum Our outdoor, bilingual Stations of the Cross had the largest attendance so far with faithful coming from other parishes to pray with us. Thank you, April and the Saint Jude community. Gracias a Dios! Thank you to Norberto for his hard work these days; Dios lo bendiga. The Vigil is always so special, and this year was no different as Father Rene and I gathered with the Saint Agnes and Saint Jude communities for a bilingual blessing of the fire and Paschal Candal. Father Rene left to bring the blessed fire in a lantern to Saint Jude's and we moved indoors for our celebration receiving eight new Catholics into our Holy Faith. I truly rejoice in taking this opportunity to review these great moments in our parish life. Now, we continue to sing Alleluia whenever possible, and we meditate on the Lord's triumph over sin and death. Lord, we thank You for everything and we love and esteem You. Thank you for Your Passion, Death and Resurrection. An anonymous person once said, "It wasn't nails that held Him to the Cross, but His love for you and me." Jesus proved how much He loves us...now it our turn to prove how much we love Him.

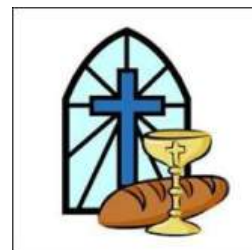
