## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Every month of the year in the Catholic faith is dedicated to a mystery of faith. March, for example, is dedicated to the great Saint Joseph or May is dedicated to Our Lady, Queen of the May. As we travel through the calendar during the month of April, we see this month dedicated to the Most Blessed Sacrament. In our parish, we are reminded about the great privilege and love for the Most Blessed Sacrament in our children receiving their First Holy Communion. Our adult, recent converts received Holy Communion for the first time, which was so beautiful at the Eater Vigil. Most of our children will receive the Lord for the first time on April 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> along with some receiving at other Masses. Our Saint Bart children, who are our “special” children are receiving Holy Communion at an earlier Mass on April 20<sup>th</sup>. May all our First Communicants remind us all that every time we receive Holy Communion, we are one step closer to eternal life with Jesus in heaven. Saint Therese of Lisieux said of her First Communion: “The time of my First Communion remains engraved in my heart as a memory without any clouds”. Oh, how beautiful to receive the Lord with attention, love and devotion! The Little Flower also called her First Communion a “kiss.” She says in her diary, “Ah! How sweet was that first kiss of Jesus! It was a kiss of love; I felt that I was loved, and I said: ‘I love You, and I give myself to you forever!’”. All that we do should give glory to God. We cleanse ourselves from the outside world first by blessing ourselves with Holy Water. We should immediately enter into silence as soon as we enter the church. A noisy church means that people are not praying! Let us give Jesus our full attention when we enter His house. Upon receiving Holy Communion, we should put out our tongue to receive Him with love or if in the hand, one hand under another and he must be consumed straightaway. He is not carried down the aisle and “popped” into our mouth. We should never leave the church and run to our car after receiving our King. Mass begins with the sign of the Cross and ends with the blessing and dismissal. Jesus deserves an hour of our time. I hate to say it, but none of us is so important that we need to run off before Mass ends. Yes, our children remind us of the glorious, special moment of our Holy Communion or oneness with the all holy. It is why the Church continues to teach that Holy Communion received in mortal sin is a sacrilegious Communion. It is always good to review the Church’s teaching on the reception of Holy Communion and to examine ourselves. Permit me again to quote Saint Therese of Lisieux again as she described “communion” perfectly: Holy Communion with Jesus. “We were no longer two, for Thérèse had disappeared like a drop of water lost in the mighty ocean. Jesus alone remained — the Master and the King. Had she not asked Him to take away her liberty, the liberty she feared? She felt so weak and frail that she wanted to unite herself forever to His Divine Strength. And her joy became so vast, so deep, that now it overflowed.” May the Lord always draw our First Communicants into His Sacred Heart and the Lord please give us all the grace to desire for He Who alone can quench our spiritual hunger and thirst!

## APRIL IS ALCOHOL AWARENESS MONTH

Alcohol-related problems continue to take a heavy toll on individuals, families, and communities. Researchers estimate that each year there are more than 178,000 alcohol-related deaths, making alcohol a leading preventable cause of death in the United States.

Unfortunately the stigma that still surrounds alcohol use may prevent people from getting the help they need. Stigma can cause people to downplay how often they drink, how much they drink, and the impact drinking has on their life.

**Identify your drinking habits:** Excessive alcohol use includes binge drinking and heavy drinking.

- Binge drinking = 5+ drinks for men and 4+ drinks for women within a 2-hour period.
- Heavy drinking = 14+ drinks for men and 7+ drinks for women within a week.

**Understand the dangers of alcohol:** Excessive alcohol use increases a person's risk of stroke, liver cirrhosis, alcoholic hepatitis, cancer, and other serious health conditions. It leads to risk-taking behavior, such as driving while impaired. Alcohol also increases the risk of death from car crashes, injuries, homicide, and suicide.

**If you think you may have a problem** It is important to overcome stigma, be honest about your drinking habits, and seek support from a health care provider.



**Check Your Alcohol Use:**

- Set a daily and weekly drinking limit
- Write down your limit and keep it with you
- Record how much you drink each day
- Avoid situations and triggers that cause you to drink
- Ask a friend to help you stay within your limit
- Talk with a doctor about your alcohol use

**What is a Standard Drink?**

- 12 ounces of beer (5% alcohol content).
- 8 ounces of malt liquor (7% alcohol content).
- 5 ounces of wine (12% alcohol content).
- 1.5 ounces or a "shot" of 80-proof (40% alcohol content) distilled spirits or liquor (e.g., gin, vodka, rum, tequila, whiskey, brandy).
