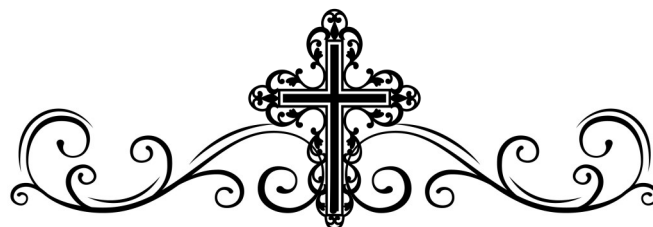

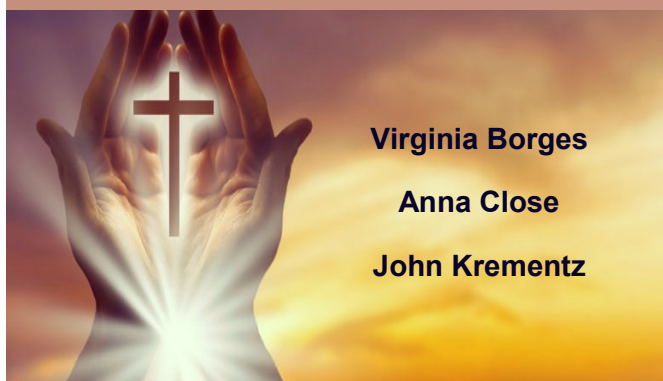

## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Palm Sunday! Today, we rejoice in our Savior's triumphant entry into Jerusalem. There are great opportunities for one to immerse themselves in the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord Jesus. On Tuesday, March 26th at 3:30 PM the bishop will be at our parish to celebrate the Chrism Mass where all the priests of our diocese come to renew their promises made at ordination and the Holy Oils are blessed for use across the entire diocese. Then the days really intensify. Holy Thursday will begin with Morning Prayer at 9:00 AM (as is custom, there is no Mass in the morning). The Holy Triduum begins with Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday, March 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM. This beautiful Mass has the Mandatum or Command to Wash Feet along with a Procession of the Most Blessed Sacrament to the Chapel. Adoration in the Chapel will take place until 11:30 PM ending with Compline (Night Prayer). Good Friday begins with Morning Prayer (No Mass) at 9:00 AM. As has been our custom, bilingual Stations of the Cross will take place at 12:00 Noon on the field of the Saint Agnes campus. The Lord's Passion, Adoration of the Holy Cross and Holy Communion takes place at 3:00 PM. We will have a tomb in Saint Agnes Church containing a statue of the Dead Christ for Prayer. Stations of the Cross will take place in the church at 7:00 PM. Holy Saturday will begin with Morning Prayer at 9:00 AM, and an Easter Egg Hunt, sponsored by the Youth Group. Easter Baskets will be blessed at 11:00 AM in the church vestibule. This Polish, Ukrainian custom is shared by many people, and all are welcome. The Easter Vigil, the holiest time of the Church Year, begins with the Easter Fire at 8:00 PM. The opening will be bilingual with the Blessed Fire being carried to Saint Jude Church for the Spanish Mass and into Saint Agnes Church for Mass in English. It is at this Mass that catechumens and candidates become Roman Catholic. Please see our schedule for Easter. This special time will surely allow us to bring our hearts closer to the mystery of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It is a great honor to pray with you over these days. Please make every effort to come to your parish to honor the Lord Jesus. Deseo a Padre René y nuestra querida comunidad latina una bendita Semana Santa. 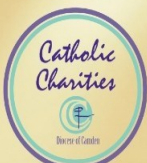

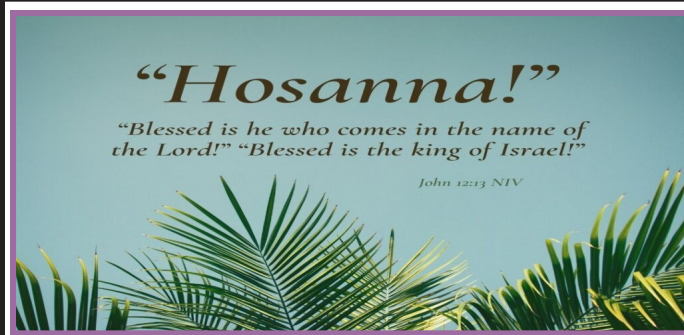
