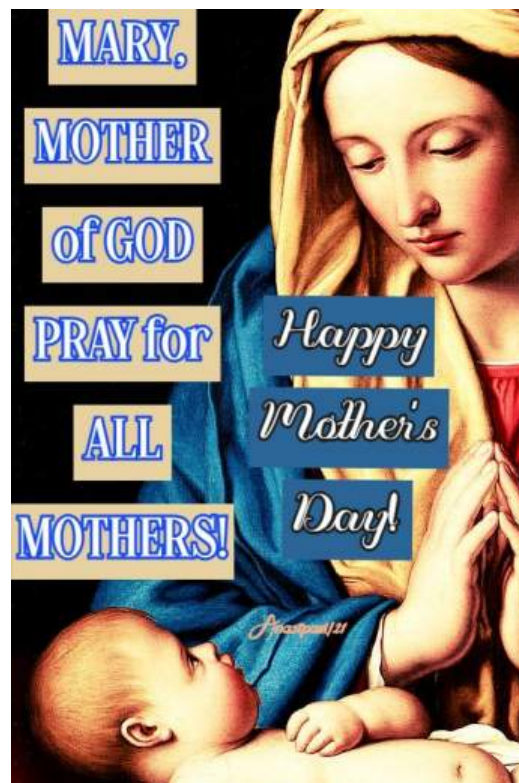


A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend our nation celebrates the beautiful vocation of motherhood. On behalf of the entire Our Lady of Hope parish I want to wish you wonderful women, a Happy Mother's Day! Perhaps, our mothers may no longer be with us and so there is some sadness. We may have infirmed mothers who cannot do what they used to do, but are special as always. You who are mothers may miss your children who live far away or cannot visit you due to the constrictions of the virus rules. I often quote the former first lady, Jacqueline Kennedy, who when asked about her greatest accomplishment she said, "If you bungle raising your children, I don't think whatever else you do matters very much." Mother's Day:

Today is Mother's Day. It's a day where we pay tribute to our mothers. A day that is filled with flowers, special dinners, cards and much more. Early in 1890, Anna Jarvis of Philadelphia wanted to honor her mother, so she set a day to do just that. She went to Grafton, West Virginia, where her mother was from and she held a special service at a church for her. She wore a white carnation for symbolize her mother was deceased and she encouraged others to do the same. If your mother was still alive, you wore a pink carnation. Within 5 years of that first special day, all fifty states adopted a day for mothers. Then in 1914, President Woodrow Wilson, made Mother's Day a national holiday. Today, we have strayed from the very first ideas of what Mother's Day should look like but the message is still the same. "Honor thy mother". Sometimes, we struggle to get through our daily activities and the stresses of every day life gets the best of us. We sometimes take our moms for granted, forget to call her or simply believe she will always be with us. In this modern world, it is no longer just mothers who are in this nurturing role. It's mothers, grandmothers, sisters, aunts, and even dads who sometimes fill this role. So, today, as we celebrate Mother's Day, let us remember all the special people who are raising our children and setting them on the path of God. We thank you, love and honor you.
