## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

As I write this letter on Tuesday, it has certainly been a very eventful couple of days. Firstly, this past Thursday we began our annual Our Lady of Hope Carnival. We had three days of enjoying rides, food, and games. I thank all those who came out to support and enjoy themselves on our holy grounds. Our Carnival Committee led by Anna O'Toole, as usual, organized a great event and led our volunteers in cooking and working games was beyond great. All the food was delicious, and I thank the Comunidad de San Judes under the direction of Father Rene for their outstanding Latin food. Our Knights of Columbus ran the beer garden with Tim McHugh serving as our parish DJ. Muchisimas gracias! The only downside was the weather, the curse continues, but we smile and give thanks to the Lord and our local police for keeping us safe.

This past weekend saw us gain a new priest in our diocese, Father Ricardo Lozano Cruz. Father served this past year as a transitional deacon at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish. He also served the Saint Jude community. Father originally hails from Bogota, Colombia and brings great gifts to wherever he will be called to serve. Father was ordained at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Camden and offered his First Mass at Saint Damian Parish in Ocean City. In the months ahead, he will serve as Bishop Sullivan's side learning about the unique situation of our diocese. It was a blessing to meet our new bishop and I must say that I was very impressed. Bishop Williams clearly has the wonderful manners of a gentleman from the heartland of our country. He speaks readily of the Lord and clearly loves Sacred Scripture. Although young but the bishop comes to us possessing deep pastoral experience. He is fluent in Spanish and has a clear love for the Latino Community. Overall, I am very excited that God is blessing the diocese with a wonderful shepherd.

So, some very blessed days this past week. As we read in Sacred Scripture, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change." (James 1:17).

### Saint's Corner: Saint Barbara:

Saint Barbara was a virgin and a martyr. She lived in the 3rd/4th centuries where according to sources she was held captive by her father. He was the King of Nicomedia and he locked her away so that no man could have her. She lived inside her living quarters where she dedicated her life to becoming a Christian. When the King learned of her devotion and her desire to be a Christian, he denounced her to the prefect, who then condemned her to death. She was beheaded with her own father's sword and he in fact perished, incinerated by a bolt of lightning. Barbara has been worshipped since the 7th century. She is depicted as a young girl with a palm branch or peacock feather. Her attribute is the tower; she is involved against lightning. Barbara is the protector of architects, gunners, weapon makers, miners, masons, fireman, bell founders and those at risk of sudden death. The name Barbara is from the Greek meaning "foreigner". Saint Barbara, known in the Eastern Orthodox Church as the Great Martyr Barbara, was an early Christian Greek saint and martyr. Saint Barbara is often portrayed with miniature chains and a tower
