A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

June is the common month for graduations (although some young people have already graduated). It is normal to just want to get out of school, but like a wedding, graduation is only the beginning. The day of graduation is rightfully filled with pride, pomp, and circumstance. We need to reach goals. A diploma is a satisfactory mile marker. Like so many things, we need to ask, "Now what do I do?" Perhaps the question could be "Now what have I become?" The Lord has plans that He would love to see accomplished in each of us. Like Him, we are called to find ways to serve others and not to sit back and wait to be served. It is so important to have the right attitude. Mother Angelica once said, "We should not be as worried about the initials after our name, but rather the initials before our name." She was speaking about having St. (Saint) in front of our name. People who know God are special and when you are with them you feel something different. I can still recall the first time I was in the presence of Pope Saint John Paul II. There was electricity in the room. Every gesture, every look and each expression conveyed a zeal for life and a radiation of the Light of God. What great things we can be and do for the glory of God when He is part of our lives. If only we were as enthusiastic about our faith as we are with so many passing things: sporting events, shows, concerts, etc. These things are good to enjoy, but they cannot be ends in themselves because they do not lead to giving of oneself. This is also the month (along with May) for ordinations to the Holy Priesthood. Vince Lombardi once said, "If you aren't fired with enthusiasm, you will be fired with enthusiasm." Let us pray that all new priests will be on fire for the Holy Gospel and that the ways of this world will never wear them down, but merely help to stoke the fires that will be ignited in them at their ordination by the Holy Spirit. We should live our spiritual life as though our lives depended on it...because, actually, our lives do depend on it.


Registration is now open for our 2024-25 Faith Formation class sessions. Options include:

Saint Anthony was born Fernando Martins in Lisbon, Portugal. He was born into a wealthy family and by the age of fifteen asked to be sent to the Abbey of Santa Cruz in Coimbra, the then capital of Portugal. During his time in the Abbey, he learned theology and Latin. Following his ordination to the priesthood, he was named guest master and was responsible for the abbey's hospitality. When Franciscan friars settled a small hermitage outside Coimbra dedicated to Saint Anthony of Egypt, Fernando felt a longing to join them. Fernando eventually received permission to leave the Abbey so he could join the new Franciscan Order. When he was admitted, he changed his name to Anthony. Anthony then traveled to Morocco to spread God's truth, but became extremely sick and was returned to Portugal to recover. The return voyage was blown off-course and the party arrived in Sicily, from which they traveled to Tuscany. Anthony was assigned to the hermitage of San Paolo after local friars considered his health. As he recovered, Anthony spent his time praying and studying. He was only 35-years-old when he died and was canonized less than one year afterward by Pope Gregory IX. Saint Anthony is venerated all over the world as the Patron Saint of lost articles, and is credited with many miracles involving lost people, lost things and even lost spiritual goods. Saint Anthony's feast day is June 13.
