A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

The actor and martial arts master, Chuck Norris once said, "If your soul needs healing, the prescription you need is not Chuck Norris' tears, it's Jesus' blood." Yes, we all need to cry over our sins and faults, but it is Jesus only who saves us. One drop of His Most Precious Blood is what leads us to eternity. Chuck is correct in that "the prescription" can only come from the Divine Physician. The month of July honors the Precious Blood after the month of June which celebrates the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We honor our fathers during June and the month of the Savior of the world. The beats of the heart of the Lord continues to echo to our very day allowing us to join the rhythm of His love. We who are sinners may think that our sins are too large to be forgiven, but it is so important not to diminish our awareness through pride that His shedding of His Blood was not enough to forgive our sins. We dare not say this! Every drop was life giving and total mercy. No, our sins can be forgiven only through Him. That is why He invented the Sacrament of Confession so that He could use a priest to continue the forgiveness that was wrought on Calvary. Our prayer before the Blessed Sacrament: Holy Mass; visits to the Blessed Sacrament and Adoration during Exposition, allow us to realize that the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity bring eternal redemption. Like a radio, our prayer has us tuning in to the Real Presence adoring His Body and Blood and receiving powerful graces. Saint Faustina wrote in her diary, entry 370: "That same day, when I was in church waiting for confession, I saw the same rays issuing from the monstrance and spreading throughout the church. This lasted all through the service. After the Benediction [the rays shone out] to both sides and returned again to the monstrance. Their appearance was bright and transparent like crystal. I asked Jesus that He deign to light the fire of His love in all souls that were cold. Beneath these rays a heart will grow." The red in the rays emanating from the Heart of Jesus is His Precious Blood. Without blood, we will not last very long. Without being immersed in the Blood of Christ, we are not alive. Our soul is not on fire. This fire inspired the saints and the holy ones who today continue to pray and work for the love of God. Remember, the theme of our parish is "To make Jesus known and loved." We have our tools: the Body and Blood of Christ, the Holy Cross which wrought our salvation and the Holy Mother Mary. Oh, how blessed we are to be Catholic! How blessed to have the Mass and the Sacraments! How blessed to know Jesus' Mother and to receive her as our mother! Yes, Chuck Norris, maybe our tears will be tears of joy because our Savior shed His blood and we do not have to fear the whiles of the devil. Jesus Christ be praised!



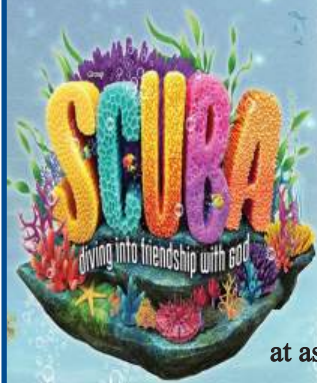

Saint Henry:

Civil leaders face many pressures because of their position. They did not have to worry about pleasing their subjects in order to stay in office. They would ignore or squelch conflict rather than deal with conflict justly. In the midst of all of this, Henry the son of the Duke of Bavaria, set an example of a Christlike leader, Saint Henry was the eldest of four children. He married St, Kunegunda, who became a Benedictine nun after his death. Henry II was emperor of Germany by the time he was thirty-four years old. As a ruler, he concentrated on the food of his people. He built monasteries, heled the poor, fought against unjust seizure of power and relieved all kinds of oppression. He was crowned emperor of the Holy Roman empire in 1014. That title made him ruler of Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Belgium, Holland and northern Italy. Although many people would envy Henry's power as ruler, he longed to be a monk and pledged obedience to the abbot. Henry was well known for his missionary spirit and for his protection. He helped with the reform of the church. Saint Henry was canonized in 1146. His feast is July 13th. Henry is the patron saint of handicapped people and people who are rejected by religious orders.
