A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

I have been to the Las Vegas area a number of times over the years as one of my sisters lived in Las Vegas and Henderson, Nevada. Fortunately, I traveled there during the month of January, so the temperature was actually chilly which is my preference. Summer is my least favorite season. Well, recently the temperature in Las Vegas broke the record at 120 degrees! I know that our recent temperatures have been very uncomfortable, but 120! Still, I can almost hear our various campus air conditioners groaning as they try to keep us comfortable. Weather affects our moods, how we dress, where we go and what is our activity level. These earthly temperatures are certainly enough to contend with, but I remember a priest telling me that while he was standing in front of the church wearing a cassock, a woman freshly said, "Aren't you hot in that thing?" He replied, "Ma'am, it was hardly comfortable on the Cross and the fires of hell are a lot hotter than this!" Bravo! Hell is a doctrine of the Church and is a reality that all too often today is rejected. *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* states, We cannot be united with God unless we freely choose to love him. But we cannot love God if we sin gravely against him, against our neighbor or against ourselves: 'He who does not love remains in death. Anyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.' Our Lord warns us that we shall be separated from him if we fail to meet the serious needs of the poor and the little ones who are his brethren. To die in mortal sin without repenting and accepting God's merciful love means remaining separated from him forever by our own free choice. This state of definitive self-exclusion from communion with God and the blessed is called "hell." (1033). Hell is also logical since there are those who choose to reject Christ or who live as though God does not exist. We are not free if there is not an alternative to Heaven. God loves us so much that He creates us with the risk that we will reject Him and choose a life outside of Him forever. We must take our ultimate destiny very seriously and realize that everything we think and do, for good or bad, has an impact on our eternal life. What can we do? Always the basics as Catholics are our aids: Holy Mass every Sunday, frequent confession, leading a life in conformity to Christ's teachings and to spend time in prayer. Everyone is busy, but our Lord was not too busy to go to Calvary to rescue us from sin and death and to open the gates of Heaven. May this summer give us some time to think where we are going, not only on our vacation, but where we want to spend eternity. It may seem hotter than hell, but in reality, it is not!





He will likely be proclaimed a saint in 2025 during the church's jubilee year. Praise be to God for this wonderful and exciting news.
