A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

When we hear the word “picnic,” it may conjure up wonderful memories from the past or excitement for a coming picnic with family and friends. I was very blessed to have grown up with a pool and to often have our yard filled with grilled food, games, and joy. On the other hand, we have all experienced Memorial Days when it rained or was chilly. When in doubt as to what to eat, a good cheeseburger is still my go to meal, but the array of food at picnics is something that can be pure Americana such as hotdogs, ribs, corn-on-the-cob, potato, and macaroni salads, etc. My favorite dessert that I have not had in years is homemade ice cream, preferably strawberry. Where does the word “picnic” come from? It comes from the French word pique-nique which was anglicized into picnic in the United States around the year 1800. According to some dictionaries, the French word pique-nique is based on the verb piquer, which means 'pick', 'peck', or 'nab', and the rhyming addition nique, which means 'thing of little importance', 'bagatelle', 'trifle' (Wikipedia). Now, why am I simply reminiscing about picnics past? I believe that we must beware that our spiritual life can be based on a picnicking mentality. We know that picnic food is not the healthiest of all foods or that at times, a formal, sit-down dinner is called for. A picnic is not possible all year round. I think that too often our spiritual life is prayer that is enjoyable but will not give us the spiritual nourishment we need. Saying a few prayers when we are desperate or only on Sundays. Perhaps we never read anything spiritual and do not spend extended times in prayer. One of the reasons I believe that our parish is doing well is because of the many people that spend time praying in the Chapel during the day, going to a prayer meeting or praying at the grotto. A disciplined prayer life is essential to having our soul properly nourished. Prayer should be a joy (so picnic is not bad), but we also need to be serious. There is a great deal happening on a global level, including in the Universal Church. There are evil forces that are operative, so we need to have our relationship with Jesus in good order. The summer is not a time to pick at various aspects of our Catholic faith, but rather to embrace our faith with gusto and with fidelity to the Lord Jesus, Who never changes, but rather transforms us. We have every hope as disciples of Jesus. Our Lady at Fatima said: “In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph,” she vowed to the children, and to all of us who read her words. Pain and suffering do not have the last word...we are called to remember that though the battle has been won for us, we cannot sit idly by and wait for the end of our earthly days. There are sins to repent of, our brothers and sisters to pray for, our God to adore, and his mother to love.” Soon enough, the picnic will be over.



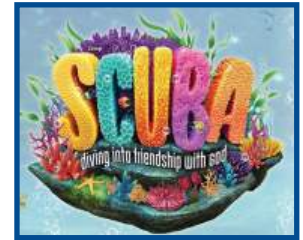
