### R.C.I.A. - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), also known as the catechumenate, is the traditional way the Catholic Church extends a welcoming invitation to non-Catholic men and women inquiring about Catholic belief and practice. ### Saint Corner:

Saint Olaf of Norway, the son of a Norwegian lord, was born in 995. Much of his youth was spent as a pirate. After being baptized, he left the pirate life for a life of faith. After capturing most of Norway from the control of the Danes and Swedes, Olaf became King. He tried to unify and make Norway a Christian country. His subjects rebelled and he was forced to flee Norway. He returned later and attempted to regain his kingdom but he was killed in the process. Miracles were later reported at his shrine, which eventually became Cathedral of Trondheim and a place of pilgrimage for the Scandinavians. Olaf was canonized by Pope Alexander and is regarded as the Patron Saint of Norway.

A reflection for Saint Olaf is: Through our efforts to bring others to God, we are sometimes required to take grave risks, as Saint Olaf was called to do. It is our knowledge that God is truly with us that sustains our quest.

**Prayer:** Lord, our God, through the intercession of St. Olaf of Norway, may we always have the courage of our convictions and staunchly defend the rights of all people to honor You. This we ask through Christ our Lord. Amen.

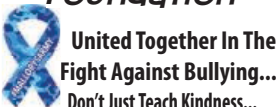
