## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

The powerful Church event that took place on American soil has concluded, but in reality, it is just beginning. I am speaking about the 10<sup>th</sup> Eucharistic Congress, which took place in Indianapolis, Indiana from July 17 – 21, 2024. Over 60,000 pilgrims traveled from across our nation to honor the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, Our Lord, and Savior in the Most Blessed Sacrament. While I could not attend in person, I followed the events closing via EWTN. Our coadjutor bishop, Joseph Williams was present as were pilgrims from our diocese. We were blessed to have parishioners from Our Lady of Hope attend the Congress, therefore, we were represented. Saint Padre Pio once said, “Every Holy Mass, heard with devotion, produces in our souls marvelous effects, abundant spiritual and material graces which we, ourselves, do not know...It is easier for the earth to exist without the sun than without the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass!” The Blessed Sacrament is the living, beating heart of our parish. So many people, so many hours with Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament! We are extremely blessed to have our huge Filipino population in Our Lady of Hope Parish. A beloved native of the Philippines, Luis Antonio Cardinal Tagle, was the representative of Pope Francis at the Congress in the United States of America. He was the celebrant of the Holy Mass which closed the Congress in Lucas Oil Stadium. The Cardinal was quoted in an article by Gretchen Crowe, “The cardinal asked those present to examine their own consciences in considering why some people choose to walk away from the Eucharistic Lord, preferring ‘his absence rather than his presence in their lives.’ ‘I invite you to pause and ask rather painful questions about this mysterious rejection of Jesus by his disciples -- by his disciples,’ Cardinal Tagle said. ‘Is it possible that we disciples contribute to the departure of others from Jesus?’ ‘Why do some people leave Jesus, when he is giving the most precious gift of eternal life? Why do some baptized turn away from the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist?’ he asked. ‘Does our biblical, catechetical, and liturgical formation allow the gift of Jesus’ person to shine forth clearly? Does our Eucharistic celebration manifest Jesus’ presence or does it obscure the presence of Jesus?’ Finally, the cardinal said, as attendees go forth, will they stay with Jesus? ‘Those who choose to stay with Jesus will be sent by Jesus,’ he said. ‘The gift of his presence and love for us will be our gift to people. We should not keep Jesus to ourselves. That is not discipleship. That is selfishness. The gift we have received we should give as a gift.’” We must give example of our belief and love for the Most Blessed Sacrament: our comportment at Mass, singing to praise of God, answering the responses with attendance, not running to the rest room every five minutes and only speaking in church in hushed tones when necessary are ways that we give example to others and remind all present that we are in the presence of His Majesty, Christ the Lord. May the fruit of the Congress spread across our nation changing hearts, starting with our own.

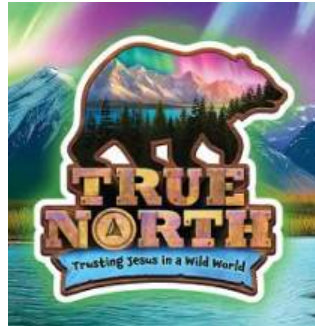

### Saints Corner:

Universally known as "Curé of Ars, Saint John Vianney was ordained a priest in 1815. Three years later he was made parish priest of Ars, a remote French hamlet, where his reputation as a confessor and director of souls made him known throughout the Christian world. His life was one of extreme mortification. Accustomed to the most severe austerities, beleaguered by swarms of penitents, and besieged by the devil, this great mystic manifested perfect patience. He was a wonder-worker loved by the crowds, but he retained a childlike simplicity, and he remained to this day the living image of the priest after the Heart of Christ. John heard confessions from all over the world for sixteen hours each day. His life was filled with works of charity and love. It is reported that the worst of the sinners were converted at his mere word. He died on August 4, 1859. He was canonized on May 31, 1925 by Pope Pius XI.

The prayer for Saint John Vianney is: "Almighty and merciful God, in Saint John Vianney You have given us a Priest who was outstanding in pastoral zeal. Through his intercession help us to win brothers for Christ and together with them attain eternal glory. Amen"

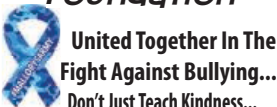
