A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

It has certainly been a sizzling summer, but I hope that everyone is having a relaxing one. Every summer, I long for the lazy, hazy days of summer from the past. Unfortunately, I do not believe that they exist anymore (at least for me). We are excited to have our second luau on Saturday, August 17th in the evening. Recently, I said at Mass, many of us remember the phrase, “Book ‘em Danno!” The theme song from the TV show literally gets the heart racing. The word “luau” is the Hawaiian word for “feast” which is certainly a very Catholic concept. The Latin for the word “feast” is *festes* which means happy or joyful. For the Church, it is a celebration of an event in the life of the Lord or the Blessed Virgin Mary. It also is a happy celebration of the saints who represent the Church Triumphant. Back to the luau...the traditional luau, after eating traditional food, often sees Hawaiian or Polynesian entertainment. This includes hula dancing or perhaps dancing with fire. We will have the hula and fire dancing this year at our event. There will also be a DJ. Our luau will include a roasted pig and other meats along with various salads. We will have a margarita machine to order drinks. One can bring their own beverage and lawn chairs or blankets. We will have activities for the children as well. Get your ticket as soon as possible. You may go online to obtain your tickets, or you may stop by the Parish Office. The first priests to arrive in Hawaii were sent from Rome arriving on July 7, 1827. The first recorded Mass on the land of Hawaii was offered on July 13th of that year. This very property in Honolulu is still used for worship since it is the site of the Cathedral of Our Lady of Peace. After persecution, the Catholic faith exploded on the Hawaiian Islands. In 1845 King Kamehameha III gave land on the island of Oahu to the Church to build a Catholic school. The faith especially flourished in Maui. Two priests arrived on the island of Maui after thousands being catechized in the faith by a layman, Helio Mahoe. The priests arrived at Maui on April 21, 1846, where over 4,000 Hawaiian awaited to be baptized into the holy faith. Of course, Saint Damian of Molokai, the great missionary to the lepers is part of the great faith in Hawaii as well as Saint Marianne Cope who also worked at the leper colony. So, our luau is rooted not only in fun, but in faith as well. Na ke Akua e ho‘opōmaika‘i iā ‘oe a ke kakali nei mākou e ‘ike iā ‘oe ma ka luau! (God bless you and we look forward to seeing you at the luau!). Aloaha!

Welcome to Catechists Corner



This is Tara Whelan. Tara and her husband, Matt both teach for us. Tara is a one to one aide. She shares her love for her faith and children in her service as a catechist for Son Seekers & Children's Liturgy. Having the opportunity to

teach her own children is when she started in this ministry. Her children are now out of the program but she remains a catechist. Tara's daughter now assists in the classroom. Tara shared how much she and her daughter enjoyed seeing the children they taught celebrate their First Communion. She said the children teach her something new everyday!

Saints Corner:

Saint Clare was born to a wealthy family in Assisi, Italy. As a teenager, she became aware Francis, the handsome, wealthy leader of the youth, had changes. He used to spend a great deal of money, Now he had no money, no possessions and no family. He dressed in a brown robe, begged for money and lived on the streets. Yet, Francis seemed to enjoy life more than ever. Gradually Clare saw that the source of his joy and inner peace was his living in poverty like Jesus. In 1211, Clare left home to join Francis. He cut off her long hair, gave her a rough, woolen habit to wear and took her to stay with the Benedictine sisters. When he found a little house near San Damiano church, he moved Clare and other women who joined her into this little place and guided her in beginning a new religious order. Clare did not leave this place and yet she was known all over. Once in 1211 and again in 1241, the convent was threatened by invasions. Panic spread throughout and Clare told the sisters to be not afraid and to trust in Jesus. They did trust in Jesus and both times they were spared. After twenty-seven years of illness, Clare died. Pope Pius VII made Clare the patron saint of television because it is said she saw the crib and heard singing in the church while lying in bed like she was there.

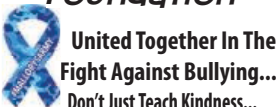
