A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

This year there was a lot of controversy surrounding the Summer Olympics which took place in Paris. The opening ceremony appeared to mock the Last Supper of Our Lord with various drag people and a big lady in the place of Jesus. Some have said that it had nothing to do with the Last Supper, but when one compares Leonardo Da Vinci's painting of the Last Supper and the position of the characters along with the central figure wearing a halo, it is difficult to come to any other conclusion. While the Olympics are open to all people and all faiths, it is shocking to mock the very roots of France which is Roman Catholic. Regretfully, France is only 47.4 % Roman Catholic. France has been called the Eldest Daughter of the Church because of her long history of faith with a magnificent list of saints. Our Lady has appeared in that land numerous times including Lourdes, LaSalette, and Rue du Bac. I do not believe that we should mock any faith as this is so personal. My thought is that it also will be judged by God. Even the closing ceremonies had bizarre, monstrous creatures that made one's skin crawl. The creature in gold was hard to look at. One of the commentators said during the presentation, "France is so cool." Yes, the food, the art, the fashion, the language, the architecture including its beautiful churches are cool. Anything that mocks its very foundation is far from "cool." Over 1,000 churches were set afire, vandalized, and subjugated to theft in France in 2018 alone. Heaven help us! Our Lady of Lourdes forgive us! One of the lights of the Olympics for me was the storied American swimmer Katy Ledecky who is a devout Catholic from Bethesda, Maryland and who attending Catholic grade school and high school. I think the beauty of Catholicism is its consistency through both successes and difficulties. I've counted on my faith to give me strength through both training and competition — but also in school, with my family and everyday life. So, while my goals in the pool have changed, my faith remains something that's consistent and something I can always rely on." When asked what she appreciates most about Catholicism, she answered, "I think our devotion to Mary is very beautiful. She has a sacred role in Catholicism, and her strong faith and humility are things we can learn from." What an inspiration. Now that is cool!

Welcome to Catechists Corner

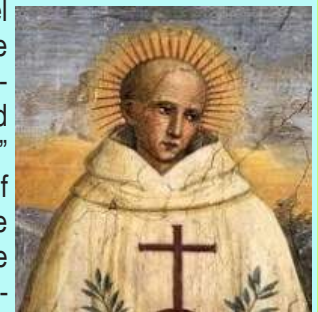


Meet Matt Whelan. Matt and his lovely wife Tara both teach in Faith Formation and Children's Liturgy. Matt was tapped by Tara (thanks Tara) to become a catechist when their children were small. They both have been catechists & Leading Children's Liturgy for over 20 years!

Now their grown children assist in the classroom! Matt enjoys getting to know the kids and their different personalities. His goal is to make their Faith journey enjoyable and strengthen their beliefs.

Saints Corner:

Saint Bernard was born to wealthy parents. Children often surprise their parents and Bernard was no exception. At the age of twenty-two, he decided on becoming a monk. The most likely choice was for him to enter the monastery at Cluny. The Benedictine monks had a reputation for holiness and the place was alive with young, enthusiastic men. He chose to join the Cistercians in a poor, crumbling monastery called Citeaux. The older monks there lived a stricter life of prayer, silence and penance. Bernard was so eager about his choice that, by the time he left home, thirty one other men decided to enter with him. Among them were four of his brothers, his uncle and his cousin. These people brought vitality to the Citeaux. Within in three years Bernard was sent to start a new monastery in a place that came to be named Clairvaux. As abbot, Bernard wanted to establish a life-style opposite to the worldly, powerful ways of the rich. In the first year he was strict about meals, work, prayers and sleep. Then he became sick and learned to be more understanding of human needs. His father and younger brother also decided to become monks with him. During his busy years as abbot, Bernard longed for solitude and time to live a simple, monk's life. However, almost daily he received visitors and letters asking for advice and help, He was called on to travel to various countries and give advice on Church and government affairs. Bernard is referred as the "Doctor of the Church" for his writings on the love of God, Scripture, the spiritual life and Mary. St. Bernard is the patron saint of Gibraltar, candlemakers and beekeepers.



Wow! Wow!

Our Son Seekers session of August 5-9, 2024 was fantastic. We hosted 95 children who attended Mass every day, spent time learning about Jesus and were active in a community service. The children made peanut butter and jelly sandwiches, utensil bags and placemats for the Cathedral Kitchen in Camden. This past week, our children made 810 sandwiches, 250 utensil bags and 46 placemats. The kitchen staff was so grateful to the children for all their efforts. We are so very proud of them!
