A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK





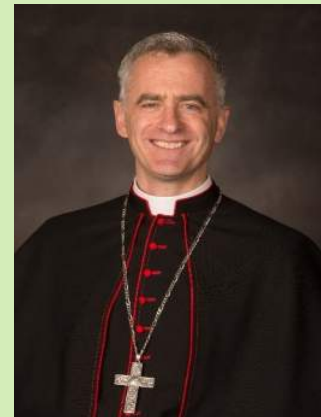

He grew up in Stillwater, Minnesota. He has a brother who is also a priest. Bishop Williams went to the University of Minnesota and graduated with a B.A in biology. From there, he studied philosophy and theology in Ohio. He then went on to Divinity school in St Paul, Minnesota. He was ordained a deacon on November 17, 2001. On May 25, 2002, at the age of 28, he was ordained a priest. He has a longstanding ministry with Latino and Spanish speaking communities. He has worked tirelessly to bring healing to the wounded Latino community and change the perception of undocumented immigrants. On January 25, 2022, he was ordained a bishop, becoming the Most Reverend Joseph A. Williams. His holiness, Pope Francis, appointed him Coadjutor Bishop of Camden on May 21, 2024. He will work side by side with Bishop Sullivan until March 2025.

"Father, we ask that you help Bishop Williams lead our Diocese, our parish and all the faithful, in our journey that leads us to you. Amen."
