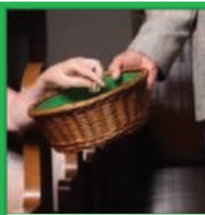


Needed: CEREAL, PEANUT BUTTER, and INSTANT POTATOES.

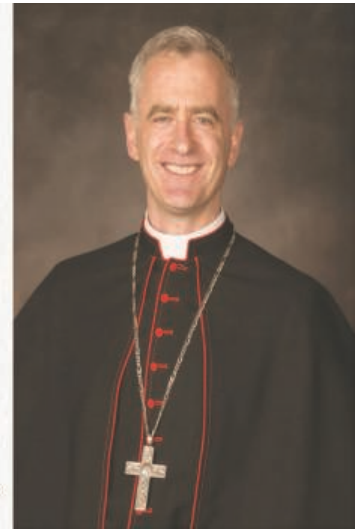

Welcome to Catechists Corner



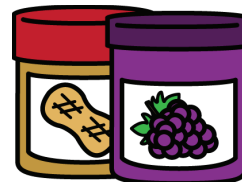
