A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. JOSEPH T. SZOLACK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Bishop Joseph Williams, the Coadjutor Bishop of Camden, has been officially welcomed to the Diocese of Camden. The Bishop was not installed as the Ordinary of the Diocese of Camden but was welcomed so that he will automatically become our Chief Shepherd on March 17, 2025. Bishop Sullivan will then become our Bishop Emeritus. Once again, our parish was at the center of this historical and very spiritual Mass and celebration. Hopefully, as so few could be present, you watched the Mass on livestream. God has blessed us in Bishop Williams, and I know that he will bring a deep love for the Most Blessed Sacrament and for Our Lady to our diocese. This weekend, the Church honors Our Lady of Sorrows on her Feast Day which falls on September 15th. Sometimes this feast day is known as Our Lady of the Seven Sorrows. What are the Seven Sorrows of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary? The Sorrows are:

1. The Prophecy of Simeon in Luke 2;
2. The Flight into Egypt in Matthew 2;
3. The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple of Jerusalem, also in Luke 2;
4. Mary meeting Jesus on the Via Dolorosa, the Fourth station of the Cross which is not found in Bible;
5. The Crucifixion of Jesus on Mount Calvary in Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, and especially John 19;
6. Jesus's Descent from the Cross in Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, and John 19;
7. The Burial of Jesus by Joseph of Arimathea also in Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, and John 19.

Sister would say when it was hot, or we were waiting in a line for something, rather than complain, we were encouraged to “offer it up.” In other words, identify with the suffering of Christ in our own small way and the burden will become not only bearable, but also efficacious with grace. Our Mother teaches us how to suffer with Jesus and for Jesus. With Him, we can help to save souls, including our own.
